Bible Study #1 Prophecy of the Kingdoms

2 Timothy 3:16	All Scripture is given by <i>inspiration of God</i> , and is profitable <u>for doctrine</u> , for <u>reproof</u> , for <u>correction</u> , for <u>instruction in righteousness</u>
2 Peter 1:21	for prophecy never came by the will of man , but <u>holy men of God spoke</u> as they were moved by the Holy Spirit .
Psalms 119:160	Thy word is true <u>from the beginning</u> : and every one of Thy righteous judgments <u>endureth for ever</u> .
Psalms 12:6	The words of the LORD are pure words: <i>as silver tried in a furnace</i> of earth, <i>purified seven times</i> .
lsaiah 14:24	The LORD of hosts hath sworn, saying, Surely as I have <u>thought</u>, so shall it come to pass ; and as I have <u>purposed</u>, so shall it stand
Isaiah 55:11	So shall <u>My word</u> be that goeth forth out of My mouth: it <i>shall not return unto Me void</i> , but it <u>shall accomplish</u> that which I please, and it <u>shall</u> <u>prosper</u> in the thing whereto I sent it.
Isaiah 46:9	Remember the former things of old: For I am God , and <u>there is none else;</u> I am God , and <u>there is none like Me</u> ,
Isaiah 46:10	Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the <i>things that are not yet done</i> , saying, <u>My counsel shall stand</u> , and I will do all My pleasure
John 14:29	And now I have told you before it comes , that when it does come to pass , you may <u>believe</u> .
Revelation 1:1	The <u>Revelation of Jesus Christ</u> , which God gave unto Him, to show unto His servants things which must shortly come to pass ; and He sent and <u>signified</u> it by His angel unto His servant John:
Revelation 1:2	Who bare record of the <u>word of God</u> , and of the testimony of <u>Jesus</u> <u>Christ</u> , and of all things that he saw .
Revelation 1:3	Blessed is he that <u>readeth</u> , and they that <u>hear</u> the words of this prophecy, and <u>keep</u> those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand.

2 Peter 1:20	knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture is of any private interpretation
Luke 10:21	In that hour Jesus rejoiced in the Spirit and said, "I thank You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from the wise and <u>prudent</u> and revealed them to <i>babes</i>. Even so, Father, for so it seemed good in Your sight."
Matthew 18:3	[Jesus] said, "Assuredly, I say to you, unless you are <u>converted</u> and become as little children, you will by no means enter the kingdom of <u>heaven</u> ."
2 Peter 3:15	and consider that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation— as also our beloved brother Paul, according to the wisdom given to him, has written to you,
2 Peter 3:16	as also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things, in which are some things hard to understand , which untaught and unstable people twist to their own destruction , as <u>they do also the rest of the Scriptures</u> .
1 Corinthians 2:13	These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which the <u>Holy Spirit teaches</u> , <i>comparing spiritual things with</i> <i>spiritual</i> .
Isaiah 28:9	"Whom will he teach knowledge ? And whom will he make to understand the message ? Those just weaned from milk? Those just drawn from the breasts?
Isaiah 28:10	For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept, Line upon line, line upon line, Here a little, there a little."
Motthew 24:27	Dut as the days of Neath were so also will the coming of the Son of Man
Matthew 24:37	But as the days of Noah were , <u>so also will the coming of the Son of Man</u> <u>be</u> .
Matthew 24:38	For as in the days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark,
Matthew 24:39	and did not know until the flood came and took them all away , <u>so also</u> will the coming of the Son of Man be.

Luke 24:25	Then He said to them, "O <u>foolish</u> ones, and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken!
Luke 24:26	Ought not the Christ to have suffered these things and to enter into His glory?"
Luke 24:27	And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets , <i>He expounded</i> to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself.
Daniel 2:1	And in the second year of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar Nebuchadnezzar dreamed dreams, wherewith his spirit was troubled, and his sleep brake from him.
Daniel 2:2	Then the king commanded to call the <u>magicians</u> , and the <u>astrologers</u> , and the <u>the sorcerers</u> , and the <u>Chaldeans</u> , for to show the king his dreams. So they came and stood before the king.
Daniel 2:3	And the king said unto them, I have dreamed a dream, and my spirit was troubled to know the dream.
Daniel 2:4	Then spake the Chaldeans to the king in Syriac, O king, live for ever: tell thy servants the dream, and we will show the interpretation.
Daniel 2:5	The king answered and said to the Chaldeans, The thing is gone from me: if ye will not make known unto me the dream, with the interpretation thereof, ye shall be cut in pieces, and your houses shall be made a dunghill.
Daniel 2:6	But if ye show the dream, and the interpretation thereof, ye shall receive of me gifts and rewards and great honour: therefore show me the dream, and the interpretation thereof.
Daniel 2:7	They answered again and said, Let the king tell his servants the dream, and we will show the interpretation of it.
Daniel 2:8	The king answered and said, I know of certainty that ye would gain the time, because ye see the thing is gone from me .
Daniel 2:9	But if ye will not <i>make known unto me the dream</i> , there is but one decree for you: for ye have prepared lying and corrupt words to speak before me, till the time be changed: therefore tell me the dream, and I shall know that ye can show me the interpretation thereof.
Daniel 2:10	The Chaldeans answered before the king, and said, There is not a man upon the earth that can show the king's matter : therefore there is no king, lord, nor ruler, that asked such things at any <u>magician</u> , or <u>astrologer</u> , or <u>Chaldean</u> .

Daniel 2:11	And it is a rare thing that the king requireth, and there is none other that can show it before the king, <u>except the gods</u> , whose dwelling is not with flesh.
Daniel 2:12	For this cause the king was angry and very furious, and commanded to destroy all the wise men of Babylon.
Daniel 2:13	And the decree went forth that the wise men should be slain; and they sought Daniel and his fellows to be slain.
Daniel 2:14	Then Daniel answered with counsel and wisdom to Arioch the captain of the king's guard, which was gone forth to slay the wise men of Babylon:
Daniel 2:15	He answered and said to Arioch the king's captain, Why is the decree so hasty from the king? Then Arioch made the thing known to Daniel.
Daniel 2:16	Then Daniel went in, and desired of the king that he would give him time, and that he would show the king the interpretation.
Daniel 2:17	Then Daniel went to his house, and made the thing known to Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah, his companions:
Daniel 2:18	That they would desire mercies of the God of heaven concerning this secret; that Daniel and his fellows should not perish with the rest of the wise men of Babylon.
Daniel 2:19	Then was the secret revealed unto Daniel in a night vision . Then Daniel blessed the God of heaven.
Daniel 2:20	Daniel answered and said, Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever: for wisdom and might are His:
Daniel 2:21	And He changeth the times and the seasons: He removeth kings, and setteth up kings : He giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding:
Daniel 2:22	<u>He revealeth the deep and secret things</u> : <u>He knoweth what is in the</u> <u>darkness</u> , and the light dwelleth with Him .
Daniel 2:23	I thank thee, and praise thee, O thou God of my fathers, who hast given me wisdom and might, and hast made known unto me now what we desired of thee: for thou hast now made known unto us the king's matter.
Daniel 2:24	Therefore Daniel went in unto Arioch, whom the king had ordained to destroy the wise men of Babylon: he went and said thus unto him; Destroy not the wise men of Babylon: bring me in before the king, and I will show unto the king the interpretation.
Daniel 2:25	Then Arioch brought in Daniel before the king in haste, and said thus unto him, I have found a man of the captives of Judah, that will make known unto the king the interpretation.
Daniel 2:26	The king answered and said to Daniel, whose name was Belteshazzar, Art thou able to make known unto me the dream which I have seen, and the interpretation thereof?

Daniel 2:27	Daniel answered in the presence of the king, and said, The secret which the king hath demanded cannot the wise men, the <u>astrologers</u> , the <u>magicians</u> , the <u>soothsayers</u> , show unto the king;
Daniel 2:28	But there is a God in heaven that revealeth secrets , and maketh known to the king Nebuchadnezzar what shall be in the latter days . Thy dream, and the visions of thy head upon thy bed, are these;
Daniel 2:29	As for thee, O king, thy thoughts came into thy mind upon thy bed, what should come to pass hereafter: and He that revealeth secrets maketh known to thee what shall come to pass.
Daniel 2:30	But as for me, <u>this secret is not revealed to me for any wisdom that I have</u> <u>more than any living</u> , but for their sakes that shall make known the interpretation to the king, and that thou might know the thoughts of thy heart.
Daniel 2:31	Thou, O king, sawest, and behold a great image. This great image, whose brightness was excellent, stood before thee; and the form thereof was terrible.
Daniel 2:32	This image's head was of fine gold , his breast and his arms of silver , his belly and his thighs of bronze ,
Daniel 2:33	His legs of iron, his feet part of iron and part of clay.
Daniel 2:34	Thou sawest till that a <u>stone</u> was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet that were of iron and clay, and brake them to pieces.
Daniel 2:35	Then was the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver, and the gold, broken to pieces together, and became like the chaff of the summer threshingfloors; and the wind carried them away, that no place was found for them: and the <u>stone</u> that smote the image became a great mountain, and filled the whole earth.
Daniel 2:36	This is the dream; and we will tell the interpretation thereof before the king.
Daniel 2:37	Thou, O king, art a king of kings: for the God of heaven hath given thee a kingdom, power, and strength, and glory.
Daniel 2:38	And <i>wheresoever</i> the children of men dwell, the beasts of the field and the fowls of the heaven hath he given into thine hand , and hath made thee ruler over them all. Thou art this head of gold .
Daniel 2:39	And after thee shall arise another kingdom inferior to thee, and another third kingdom of bronze , which shall bear rule over all the earth.
Daniel 2:40	And the fourth kingdom shall be strong as iron : forasmuch as iron breaketh in pieces and subdueth all things : and as iron that breaketh all these, shall it break in pieces and bruise.



Daniel 2:41	And whereas thou sawest the feet and toes , part of potters' clay , and part of iron , the kingdom shall be divided ; but there shall be in it of the strength of the iron , forasmuch as thou sawest the iron mixed with <i>miry</i> clay .
Daniel 2:42	And as the toes of the feet were part of iron, and part of clay, so the kingdom shall be partly strong , and partly broken .
Daniel 2:43	And whereas thou sawest iron mixed with miry clay , they shall <u>mingle</u> <u>themselves with the seed of men</u> : but they shall <u>not cleave one to</u> <u>another</u> , even as iron is not mixed with clay .



Daniel 2:34	Thou sawest till that a <u>stone</u> was cut out without hands , which smote the image upon his feet
Daniel 2:35	Then was the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver, and the gold, broken to pieces together, and became like the chaff of the summer threshingfloors; and the wind carried them away, that no place was found for them: and the <u>stone</u> that smote the image became a great mountain, and filled the whole earth.
Daniel 2:44	And <u>in the days of these kings</u> shall the God of heaven set up a kingdom , which shall never be destroyed: and the kingdom shall not be left to other people, but it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand for ever.
Daniel 2:45	Forasmuch as thou sawest that the <u>stone</u> was cut out of the mountain without hands, and that it brake in pieces the iron, the brass, the clay, the silver, and the gold; the great God hath made known to the king what shall come to pass hereafter: and the dream is certain, and the interpretation thereof sure.

Daniel 2:35	the <u>stone</u> that smote the image became a great mountain, and filled the whole earth.
Daniel 2:44	And <u>in the days of these kings</u> shall the God of heaven set up a kingdom, which shall never be destroyed
1 Peter 2:4	Coming to Him as to a living <u>stone</u> , rejected indeed by men, but chosen by God and precious,
1 Peter 2:5	you also , <i>as living stones</i> , are being built up a spiritual house , a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.
1 Peter 2:7	Therefore, to you who believe , He is precious ; but to those who are disobedient, "The <u>stone</u> which the builders rejected Has become the chief corner <u>stone</u> "
