Psalms 77:13 Thy <u>way</u>, O God, is in the sanctuary: who is so great a God as our God?



John 1:14	And the Word became <i>flesh</i> and <u>dwelt</u> among us , and we beheld His glory, <u>the glory as of the only begotten of the Father</u> , full of grace and truth.
Galatians 4:4	But <i>when the fullness of the time had come</i> , God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born <u>under the law</u> ,
Galatians 4:5	to redeem those who were <u>under the law</u> , that we might receive the adoption as sons

Hebrews 2:14	Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of <i>flesh and blood</i>, <u>He also</u> <u>Himself likewise</u> took part of the <u>same</u>
Hebrews 2:16	For verily He took not on him the nature of angels; but He took on him the seed of Abraham .
Hebrews 2:17	Wherefore in all things it behoved Him to be made like unto his brethren , that He might be a <u>merciful and faithful high priest</u> in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people.
Hebrews 2:18	For in that He Himself hath suffered being tempted , <u>He is able to</u> <u>succour them that are tempted</u> .

Leviticus 22:20	Whatever has a defect, you shall not offer, for it shall <u>not</u> be <u>acceptable</u> <u>on your behalf</u> .
Leviticus 22:21	And whoever offers a sacrifice of a peace offering to the LORD, to fulfill his vow, or a freewill offering from the cattle or the sheep, <u>it must be</u> perfect to be accepted ; there shall be no defect in it.
Leviticus 22:22	Those that are blind or broken or maimed , or have an ulcer or eczema or scabs , <u>you shall not offer</u> to the LORD, <u>nor make an offering by fire of</u> <u>them</u> on the altar to the LORD.

Exodus 12:5	Your lamb shall be without blemish , a male of the first year. You may take it from the sheep or from the goats.
1 Peter 1:18	knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers,
1 Peter 1:19	but with the precious blood of Christ , as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.
1 Peter 1:20	He indeed was <u>foreordained before the foundation of the world</u> , but was manifest in these last times for you

Leviticus 21:17	Speak to Aaron, saying: ' <u>No man</u> of your descendants in succeeding generations, <u>who has</u> any defect , <u>may approach to offer the bread of his</u> <u>God</u> .
Leviticus 21:18	For any man who has a defect shall not approach: a man blind or lame,
	who has a marred face or any limb too long ,
Leviticus 21:19	a man who has a broken foot or broken hand ,
Leviticus 21:20	or is a hunchback or a dwarf , or a man who has a defect in his eye , or eczema or scab, or is a eunuch .
Leviticus 21:21	<u>No man</u> of the descendants of Aaron the priest, <u>who has</u> a defect , <u>shall</u> <u>come near to offer the offerings made by fire to the LORD</u> . He has a defect ; he <u>shall not come near</u> to offer the bread of his God.

Hebrews 4:14	Seeing then that we have a great High Priest , that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God , let us hold fast our profession.
Hebrews 4:15	For we have not an High Priest which cannot be <u>touched with the feeling</u> of our infirmities; but was <u>in all points tempted like as we are</u> , yet without sin .
Hebrews 4:16	Let us therefore <i>come boldly unto the throne of grace</i> , that we may <i>obtain mercy, and find grace</i> to help in time of need.
Hebrews 7:26	For such an High Priest <i>became us</i> , who is holy , harmless, undefiled , separate from sinners , and made higher than the heavens
John 19:6	Therefore, when the chief priests and officers saw Him, they cried out, saying, "Crucify Him, crucify Him!" Pilate said to them, "You take Him and crucify Him, for I find no fault in Him ."





Exodus 29:38	Now this is what you shall offer on the altar : two lambs of the first year, day by day <u>continually</u> .
<u>Continual</u>	ly H8548 constant regular daily alway continual perpetual ever
Leviticus 1:3	he [the sinner] shall offer it of his own free will at the door of the tabernacle of meeting before the LORD.
Leviticus 1:4	Then he shall <u>put his hand on the head</u> of the burnt offering, and it will be accepted on his behalf to make atonement for him.
Leviticus 1:5	He shall kill [it] before the LORD; and the priests, Aaron's sons, shall bring the blood and sprinkle the blood all around on the altar

John 3:16	For <u>God so loved the world</u> that He gave His only begotten Son , that whoever believes in Him <u>should not perish but have everlasting life</u> .
2 Corinthians 5:21	For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us , that <u>we might</u> <u>become the righteousness of God in Him</u> .
Romans 6:23	For the wages of sin is death ; but the <u>gift of God is eternal life through</u> <u>Jesus Christ our Lord</u> .
1 John 2:2	And He is the <u>propitiation</u> for our sins : and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the <u>whole world</u>.
Hebrews 7:9	And as I may so say, Levi also, who receiveth tithes, payed tithes in Abraham.
Hebrews 7:10	For <i>he was yet in the loins of his father,</i> when Melchisedek met him.
Hebrews 2:9	But we see Jesus , who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death , crowned with glory and honor; that He by the grace of God should taste death for <u>every man</u> .
Galatians 3:13	Christ hath <u>redeemed us from the curse of the law</u> , being made a <u>curse</u> for us : for it is written, <u>Cursed</u> is every one that hangeth on a tree
Genesis 3:17	Then to Adam He said, Because you have heeded the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree of which I commanded you , saying, ' You shall not eat of it ': <u>Cursed is the ground</u> for your sake; in toil you shall eat of it all the days of your life.
Genesis 3:18	Both <u>thorns</u> and <u>thistles</u> it shall <i>bring forth</i> for you
Matthew 27:29	When they had twisted a <u>crown of thorns</u>, they put it on His head , and a reed in His right hand. And <u>they bowed</u> <u>the knee before Him and mocked</u> <u>Him</u> , saying, "Hail, King of the Jews!"
Matthew 27:30	Then they spat on Him, and took the reed and struck Him on the head.

Matthew 27:30	Then they spat on Him, and took the reed and struck Him on the head.
Ephesians 5:23	For the husband is head of the wife , as also Christ is <u>head of the church</u> ; and He is the Savior <u>of the body</u> .
Isaiah 53:5	But He was wounded for our transgressions , He was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace <i>was upon</i> Him; and with His stripes <u>we are healed</u> .
Isaiah 53:6	All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath <i>laid on Him</i> the <u>iniquity of us all</u> .



Exodus 40:30	[Moses] set the laver between the tabernacle of meeting and the altar , and put <u>water</u> there for <u>washing</u>.
Titus 3:5	according to His mercy He saved us , through the <u>washing</u> of regeneration and renewing <u>of the Holy Spirit</u>
Ephesians 5:26	that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the <u>washing of water</u> by the word,
Ephesians 5:27	that He might present her to Himself <u>a glorious church</u> , <u>not having spot or</u> <u>wrinkle</u> or any such thing, but that she should be <u>holy and without</u> <u>blemish</u> .
Colossians 2:12	<i>buried with Him</i> in <u>baptism</u> , in which you also were <i>raised with Him</i> through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead.
Acts 22:16	And now why are you waiting? Arise and be <u>baptized</u> , and <u>wash</u> away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord.
Acts 2:38	Then Peter said to them, " Repent , and let every one of you be <u>baptized</u> in the name of Jesus Christ for the <u>remission of sins</u> ; and you shall receive the gift of the <u>Holy Spirit</u> .
John 7:37	On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, " If anyone <u>thirsts</u>, let him come to Me and drink .
John 7:38	He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living <u>water</u> ."
John 7:39	But this He spoke concerning the <u>Spirit</u>, whom those believing in Him would receive
John 4:13	Jesus answered and said to her, "Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again,
John 4:14	but whoever <u>drinks of the water</u> that I shall give him will never thirst . But the <u>water</u> that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of <u>water</u> springing up into everlasting life."

Romans 6:9	Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead <i>dieth no more;</i> <u>death</u> <u>hath no more dominion over Him</u> .
Romans 6:10	For in that He died, He died unto sin once : but in that He liveth, He liveth unto God.
Romans 6:14	For <u>sin shall not have dominion over you</u> : for ye are <u>not under the law</u> , but <i>under grace</i> .
Acts 5:31	Him God has exalted to His right hand to be Prince and Savior, <i>to give repentance</i> to Israel and <u>forgiveness</u> of sins.
Proverbs 28:13	He who covers his sins will not prosper , but whoever <u>confesses and</u> <u>forsakes them</u> will have mercy.
Romans 4:25	Who was delivered for our offenses , and was raised again for our justification.
1 Corinthians 15:3	For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures,
1 Corinthians 15:4	and that He was buried , and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures,
1 Corinthians 15:17	And if Christ is not risen, your faith is futile ; you are still in your sins !
1 Corinthians 15:17 1 Corinthians 15:18	And if Christ is not risen, your faith is futile ; you are still in your sins ! Then also those who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished.

Leviticus 17:11	For the <u>life</u> of the flesh is in the <u>blood</u> , and <u>I have given it to you</u> upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the <u>blood</u> that makes atonement for the soul.
Psalms 51:10	<u>Create</u> in me a clean heart, O God; and <u>renew</u> a right spirit within me.
Titus 3:5	according to His mercy He saved us , through the <u>washing</u> of <u>regeneration</u> and <u>renewing</u> of the Holy Spirit
John 3:5	Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, <u>unless one is</u> born of water and the Spirit, <u>he cannot enter the kingdom of God</u> .
John 3:6	That which is born of the <u>flesh is flesh</u> , and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit .
John 3:7	Do not marvel that I said to you, ' You must be born again .'
1 Corinthians 15:22	For as <u>in Adam all die</u> , even so <u>in Christ all shall be made alive.</u>
