
The Great Advent Awakening 1840-1844

Daniel 8:15	And it came to pass, when I, even I Daniel, had seen the vision, and sought for the meaning, then, behold, there stood before me as the appearance of a man.
Daniel 8:16	And I heard a man's voice between the banks of Ulai, which called, and said, Gabriel, make this man to <i>understand</i> <u>the vision</u>.
Daniel 8:17	So he came near where I stood: and when he came, I was afraid, and fell upon my face: but he said unto me, Understand , O son of man: for at the <u>time of the end</u> shall be <u>the vision</u> .
Daniel 8:18	Now as he was speaking with me, I was in a deep sleep on my face toward the ground: but he touched me, and set me upright.
Daniel 8:19	And he said, Behold, I will make thee know what shall be in the last end of the indignation: for at the <u>time appointed the end</u> shall be.

Daniel 9:25	from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince


Daniel 8:14 And he said unto me, Unto <u>two thousand and three hundred days</u>; *then* shall the **sanctuary** be **cleansed**.

Exodus 25:8 And let them **make Me a sanctuary**, that **I may dwell among them**.

Exodus 25:9 According to all that <u>I show you</u>, that is, the <u>pattern of the tabernacle</u> and the <u>pattern of all its furnishings</u>, just so you shall make it.

Daniel 12:12 Blessed is he that <u>waiteth</u>, and cometh to the <u>thousand three hundred</u> and five and thirty days.

Hebrews 8:1	Now of the things which we have spoken this is the sum: We have such an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens;
Hebrews 8:2	A minister of the sanctuary , and of the <i>true tabernacle,</i> which the <u>Lord</u> <u>pitched</u> , and not man.
Hebrews 8:3	For every high priest is ordained to offer gifts and sacrifices: wherefore it is of necessity that this Man have somewhat also to offer.
Hebrews 8:4	For if He were on earth , He should not be a priest, seeing that there are priests that offer gifts according to the law:
Hebrews 8:5	Who serve unto the <u>example and shadow</u> of <i>heavenly things</i>, as Moses was admonished of God when he was about to make the tabernacle: for, See, saith He, that thou make all things <u>according to the pattern</u> showed to thee in the mount.
Hebrews 9:1	Then verily the first covenant had also ordinances of divine service, and a worldly sanctuary .
Hebrews 9:2	For there was a tabernacle made ; the first , wherein was the candlestick , and the showbread ; which is called the sanctuary .
Hebrews 9:3	And <u>after the second veil</u> , the tabernacle which is called the <u>Holiest of</u> <u>all</u> ;
Hebrews 9:4	Which had the golden censer , and the <u>ark of the covenant</u> overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the golden pot that had manna , and Aaron's rod that budded, and the tables of the covenant ;
Hebrews 9:5	And over it the cherubims of glory shadowing the mercy seat ; of which we cannot now speak particularly.

Hebrews 9:6	Now when these things were thus ordained, the priests went always into the first tabernacle, accomplishing the service of God.
Hebrews 9:7	But into the second went the high priest alone <u>once</u> every year, not without blood, which he offered for himself, and for the errors of the people :
Hebrews 9:8	The Holy Ghost this signifying, that the way into the holiest of all was not yet made manifest, while as the first tabernacle was yet standing:
Hebrews 9:9	Which was <u>a figure for the time then present</u> , in which were offered both gifts and sacrifices, that could not make him that did the service perfect , <i>as pertaining to the conscience</i> ;
Hebrews 9:10	Which stood only in meats and drinks, and divers washings, and carnal ordinances, imposed on them until the time of reformation.
Hebrews 9:11	But Christ being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, <u>not made with hands</u> , that is to say, not of this building;
Hebrews 9:12	Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by His own blood He entered in <u>once into the holy place</u> , having obtained eternal redemption for us.
Hebrews 9:13	For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh:
Hebrews 9:14	How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God ?

Hebrews 9:23	It was therefore necessary that the patterns of things in the heavens should be <i>purified</i> with these; but the <u>heavenly things themselves with</u> <u>better sacrifices</u> than these.
Hebrews 9:24	For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands , which are the figures of the true ; but <i>into heaven itself</i> , now to appear in the p resence of God for us:
Hebrews 9:25	Nor yet that He should offer Himself often, as the high priest entereth into the holy place every year with blood of others;
Hebrews 9:26	For then must He often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath He appeared to <u>put away sin</u> <u>by the sacrifice of Himself</u> .
Hebrews 9:27	And as it is appointed unto <i>men once to die,</i> but after this <u>the judgment</u>:
Hebrews 9:28	So <u>Christ</u> was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for Him <u>shall</u> He <u>appear the second time</u> without sin unto salvation.
Revelation 10:1	And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a <u>rainbow</u> was upon his head, and his face was as it were the sun, and his <u>feet as pillars of fire</u> :
Revelation 4:3	And He that sat [on the throne] was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and there was a <u>rainbow</u> round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald.
Revelation 1:13	And in the midst of the seven candlesticks One like unto the Son of Man
Revelation 1:15	And His <u>feet</u> like unto fine brass, <u>as if they burned in a furnace</u>
Revelation 1:16	<i>His countenance was as the sun</i> shineth in its strength.



Daniel 12:4	But thou, O Daniel, <u>shut</u> up the words, and <u>seal</u> the book, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and <u>knowledge</u> shall be increased.
Isaiah 28:9	Whom shall he <u>teach knowledge</u> ? and whom shall he make to <u>understand doctrine</u> ? them that are weaned from the milk, and drawn from the breasts.
Isaiah 28:10	For precept <i>must be</i> upon precept , precept upon precept, Line upon line, line upon line, <u>Here a little</u> , and <u>there a little</u> .
Revelation 10:2	And he had in his hand a little book <u>open</u>: and he set his right <u>foot upon</u> the <u>sea</u> and his left <u>foot on</u> the <u>earth</u>,
Isaiah 17:12	Woe to the multitude of <u>many people</u> , which make a noise like the noise of the <u>seas</u> ; and to the rushing of <u>nations</u> , that make a rushing like the rushing of <u>mighty waters</u> !
Revelation 13:11	And I beheld another beast coming up out of the <u>earth</u>; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spake as a dragon.
Revelation 10:2	And he had in his hand a little book <u>open</u>: and he set his right <u>foot upon</u> the <u>sea and his left foot on</u> the <u>earth</u>,
Ephesians 1:21	Far <u>above all</u> principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:
Ephesians 1:22	And hath put all things <u>under His feet</u> , and gave Him to be the <u>head over</u> <u>all things</u> to the church

Revelation 10:3	And cried with a loud voice, as when a <u>lion</u> roareth: and when he had cried, <u>seven thunders</u> uttered their <u>voices</u> .
Revelation 5:1	And I saw <u>in the right hand</u> of Him that sat on the throne <u>a book</u> written within and on the backside, <u>sealed</u> with seven seals.

Revelation 5:3	And <u>no man in heaven</u> , <u>nor in earth</u> , <u>neither under the earth</u> , <u>was able to</u> <u>open the book</u> , neither to look thereon.
Revelation 10:3	And cried with a loud voice, as when a <u>lion</u> roareth: and when he had cried, <u>seven thunders</u> uttered their <u>voices</u> .
Revelation 5:4	And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to <u>open</u> and to read <u>the book</u>, neither to look thereon.
Revelation 5:5	And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the <u>Lion of the</u> <u>tribe of Judah</u> , the <u>Root of David</u> , hath prevailed to <u>open the book</u> , and to loose the seven seals thereof.
Revelation 5:6	And I beheld , and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a <u>Lamb</u> as it had been <u>slain</u>
Revelation 10:4	And when the <u>seven thunders</u> had uttered their <u>voices</u> , I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, <u>Seal up those</u> <u>things which the seven thunders uttered</u> , and <u>write them not</u> .
Psalms 29:3	The voice of the LORD is over the waters; The God of glory <u>thunders</u>
Psalms 18:13	The LORD <u>thundered</u> from heaven , And the Most High uttered <u>His</u> <u>voice</u>

Revelation 10:5	And the angel which I saw stand upon the sea and upon the earth lifted up his hand to heaven,
Revelation 10:6	And swore by <u>Him</u> that liveth for ever and ever, who <u>created heaven</u> , and the things that therein are, and <u>the earth</u> , and the things that therein are, and <u>the sea</u> , and the things which are therein, that <u>there should be</u> <u>time no longer</u> :
Exodus 20:11	For in six days the <u>LORD made heaven and earth</u> , <u>the sea</u> , and all that in them is, and rested the <i>seventh day</i> : wherefore the LORD blessed the <i>sabbath day</i> , and hallowed it.
Revelation 10:7	But in the days of the voice of the <u>seventh angel</u> , when he shall <u>begin to</u> <u>sound</u> , the <u>mystery of God</u> should be <u>finished</u> , as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.
Revelation 11:18	And the nations were angry , and <u>Thy wrath is come</u> , and the <u>time of the</u> <u>dead</u> , that <u>they should be judged</u> , and that Thou shouldest give <u>reward</u> unto Thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear Thy name, small and great; and shouldest <u>destroy</u> them which destroy the earth.
Revelation 11:19	And the <u>temple</u> of God was opened <u>in heaven</u> , and there was seen in His temple the <u>ark of His testament</u> : and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail.

Ephesians 5:31	For this cause shall <u>a man</u> leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto <u>his wife</u> , and <u>they two shall be one flesh</u> .
Ephesians 5:32	This is a great mystery : but I speak concerning Christ and the church.
Malachi 3:17	And <u>they shall be Mine</u> , saith the LORD of hosts, <i>in that day</i> when I make up <u>My jewels</u> ; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son <i>that</i> <i>serveth him</i> .

1 Samuel 14:27	and dipped it in an <u>honeycomb</u> , and put his hand to his <u>mouth</u>; and <i>his</i> <u>eyes</u> were <u>enlightened</u>.
Ephesians 1:17	Godmay give unto you the <i>spirit</i> of <u>wisdom and revelation</u> in the <u>knowledge</u> of Him:
Ephesians 1:18	The eyes of your <u>understanding</u> being <u>enlightened</u>
Daniel 12:4	But thou, O Daniel, <u>shut</u> up the words, and <u>seal</u> the book, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and <u>knowledge shall be</u> increased.

Revelation 10:11	And he said unto me, Thou must <i>prophesy</i> again before <u>many peoples</u> , and <u>nations</u> , and <u>tongues</u> , and <u>kings</u> .
Revelation 14:6	Then I saw another angel flying in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach to those who dwell on the earth to every nation , tribe , tongue , and people —
Revelation 14:7	saying with a loud voice, "Fear God and give glory to Him, for <u>the hour of</u> <u>His judgment has come</u> ; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water."
Revelation 11:18	And the nations were angry , and Thy wrath is come , and the <u>time of the</u> <u>dead</u> , that <u>they should be judged</u>
Amos 3:8	The <u>lion</u> hath <u>roared</u>, who will not fear? the Lord <u>GOD</u> hath <u>spoken</u>, who can but <u>prophesy</u>?
Matthew 26:19	So the disciples did as Jesus had directed them; and they prepared the <u>Passover</u> .
Matthew 26:20	When evening had come, He sat down with the twelve.
John 19:31	Therefore, because it was the Preparation Day , that the <u>bodies should</u> <u>not remain on the cross on the Sabbath (</u> for <i>that Sabbath was a high</i> <i>day</i>)
1 Corinthians 5:7	Therefore <i>purge out the old leaven</i> , that you may be a new lump , since you truly are <u>unleavened</u> . For indeed <u>Christ</u> , <u>our Passover</u> , was sacrificed for us.
Matthew 28:1	Now <u>after the Sabbath</u> , as the <u>first day of the week</u> began to dawn, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to see the tomb.
Matthew 28:5	"Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek <u>Jesus</u> who was crucified .
Matthew 28:6	He is not here; for <u>He is risen</u> "
1 Corinthians 15:20	But now <u>Christ is</u> risen from the dead, and has become <u>the firstfruits</u> of those who have fallen asleep.
Acts 2:1	When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.



Daniel 7:9	I beheld till the thrones were cast down , and the Ancient of days did sit , whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: His throne was like the fiery flame, and His wheels as burning fire.
Daniel 7:10	A fiery stream issued and came forth from before him: thousand thousands ministered unto him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him: the judgment was set , and the books were opened .
Daniel 7:13	I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came
