1. True prophet must bear good fruit

| Matthew 7:20 | Therefore <u>by their fruits</u> you will know them. |

2. True prophet must edify the people of the church

1 Corinthians 14:3 But he who <u>prophesies</u> speaks <u>edification</u> and exhortation and comfort to men.

1 Corinthians 14:4 ...he who prophesies edifies the church.

3. True prophet must get prophecies right

Deuteronomy 18:20 But the **prophet** who presumes to speak a word in My name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or **who speaks in the name of other gods**, **that prophet shall die**.

Deuteronomy 18:21 And if you say in your heart, 'How shall we know the word which the Lord has not spoken?'--

Deuteronomy 18:22 when a **prophet speaks in the name of the Lord**, if the **thing does not happen or come to pass**, that is the thing which the **Lord has not spoken**;

the prophet has spoken it presumptuously; **you shall not be afraid of him**.

4. True prophet must declare Jesus Christ is God and exalt Him

| 1 John 4:15 | Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, God dwelleth in him , and he in God. |

| 1 John 4:2 | Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that <u>Jesus</u> Christ is come in the flesh is of God |
| 2 John 2:7 | For many <u>deceivers</u> are entered into the world, who <u>confess not</u> that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. This is a <u>deceiver</u> and an <u>antichrist</u> . |

4. True prophet must declare Jesus Christ is God and exalt Him

Deuteronomy 13:1 If there arises among you a **prophet** or a **dreamer of dreams**, and he gives you a sign or a wonder,

Deuteronomy 13:2 and the **sign or the wonder comes to pass**, of which he spoke to you, saying, 'Let us go after other gods'-- which you have not known--'and let us serve them,'

Deuteronomy 13:3 you shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams, for the Lord your God is testing you to know whether you love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul.

Deuteronomy 13:4 You shall walk after the LORD your God and **fear Him**, and **keep His commandments** and **obey His voice**; you shall **serve Him** and **hold fast to Him**.

5. True prophet must agree with the law and all the prophets

Lamentations 2:9 ...The <u>Law is no more</u>, and her prophets find <u>no vision</u> from the Lord.

1 Corinthians 14:32 And the **spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets**.

1 Corinthians 14:33 For **God is not the author of confusion** but of peace, as in all the churches of the saints.

1 Corinthians 14:37 If anyone thinks himself to be a prophet or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things which I write to you are the commandments of the Lord.

5. True prophet must agree with the law and all the prophets

John 14:26

But the Helper, the **Holy Spirit**, whom the Father will send <u>in **My name**</u>, **He will teach you all things**, and <u>bring to your remembrance all things</u>

<u>that I said to you</u>.

Isaiah 8:20 To the **law and to the testimony**: **if they speak not according to this**

word, it is because there is no light in them.

Hebrews 13:8 **Jesus Christ** is the **same yesterday**, **today**, and **forever**.

6. True prophet must speak with authority.
