## Bible Study #2 The Kingdoms Revealed

Daniel 7:1	In the first year of Belshazzar king of Babylon Daniel had a dream and visions of his head upon his bed: then he wrote the dream, and told the sum of the matters.
Daniel 7:2	Daniel spake and said, I saw in my vision by night, and, behold, the <b>four</b> winds of the heaven strove upon the great sea.
Daniel 7:3	And four great beasts came up from the sea, diverse one from another.
Daniel 7:4	The <b>first was like a lion</b> , and had <b>eagle's wings</b> : I beheld till the wings thereof were plucked, and it was lifted up from the earth, and made stand upon the feet as a man, and a man's heart was given to it.
Daniel 7:5	And behold another beast, a second, like to a bear, and it raised up itself on one side, and it had three ribs in the mouth of it between the teeth of it: and they said thus unto it, Arise, devour much flesh.
Daniel 7:6	After this I beheld, and lo <b>another</b> , <b>like a leopard</b> , which had upon the back of it <b>four wings of a fowl</b> ; the beast had also <b>four heads</b> ; and dominion was given to it.
Daniel 7:7	After this I saw in the night visions, and behold a <b>fourth beast</b> , <b>dreadful and terrible</b> , and <b>strong exceedingly</b> ; and it had <b>great iron teeth</b> : it <b>devoured and brake in pieces</b> , and stamped the residue with the feet of it: and it was <b>diverse from all the beasts that were before it</b> ; and it had <b>ten horns</b> .
Daniel 7:8	I considered the horns, and, behold, there came up among them another little horn, before whom there were three of the first horns plucked up by the roots: and, behold, in this horn were eyes like the eyes of man, and a mouth speaking great things.









Daniel 7:15	I Daniel was grieved in my spirit in the midst of my body, and the visions of my head troubled me.
Daniel 7:16	I came near unto one of them that stood by, and asked him the truth of all this. So he told me, and made me know the interpretation of the things.
Daniel 7:17	These great <b>beasts</b> , which are four, are <b>four <u>kings</u></b> , <b>which shall arise out of the earth</b> .
Daniel 7:23	Thus he said, The fourth <u>beast</u> shall be the fourth <u>kingdom</u> upon earth, which shall be <i>diverse from all <u>kingdoms</u></i> , and shall <b>devour the whole</b> earth, and shall tread it down, and break it in pieces.

Jeremiah 49:37	For I will cause Elam to be <b>dismayed before their enemies</b> , and before <b>them that seek their life</b> : and <b>I will bring evil</b> upon them, even My <b>fierce anger</b> , saith the LORD; and I will send <u>the sword</u> after them, <b>till I have consumed</b> them

Jerennan 20.4	to all thy friends: and they shall <b>fall by <u>the sword</u></b> of their enemies, and thine eyes shall behold it: and <b>I will give all Judah into the hand of the king of <u>Babylon</u></b> , and he shall carry them <b>captive into <u>Babylon</u></b> , and shall <b>slay them with <u>the sword</u></b> .
Jeremiah 49:36	four winds from the four quarters of heaven
Jeremiah 49:37	and I will send the sword after them, till I have consumed them

Jeremiah 4:5	Declare ye in Judah, and publish in Jerusalem; and say, Blow ye the trumpet in the land: cry, gather together, and say, Assemble yourselves, and let us go into the defensed cities.
Jeremiah 4:6	Set up the standard toward Zion: retire, stay not: for I will bring <b>evil from</b> the <u>north</u> , and a <b>great destruction</b> .
Jeremiah 4:7	The <u>lion</u> is come up from his thicket, and the destroyer of the Gentiles is on his way; he is gone forth from his place to <i>make thy land desolate</i> ; and thy <i>cities shall be laid waste</i> , <i>without an inhabitant</i> .
Jeremiah 50:17	Israel is a scattered sheep; the <u>lions</u> have driven him away: <b>first the king of Assyria</b> hath <u>devoured him</u> ; and <b>last this Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon</b> hath <u>broken his bones</u> .
Daniel 7:4	The <b>first was like a lion</b> , and had <u>eagle's wings</u>
Jeremiah 4:13	Behold, he shall <b>come up as clouds</b> , and his <b>chariots shall be as a whirlwind</b> : his <b>horses are swifter than eagles</b> . Woe unto us! for we are spoiled.
Deuteronomy 28:49	The <b>LORD will bring a nation against you</b> from afar, from the end of the earth, <b>as swift as the eagle flies</b> , a nation whose language you will not understand
Deuteronomy 20:1	When thou goest out to <u>battle against thine enemies</u> , and seest <i>horses</i> , and <i>chariots</i>
Revelation 19:11	And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white <i>horse</i> ; and <b>He that sat upon him</b> was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth

judge and **make war**.

Daniel 8:5

Therefore the he **goat waxed** <u>very great</u>: and when he was strong, the <u>great horn</u> was broken; and for it came up four notable ones toward the four winds of heaven.

Daniel 8:8	Therefore the he <b>goat waxed </b> <i>very great</i> the <b>great horn was broken</b> ; and for it <b>came up </b> <u>four notable ones</u> toward the <u>four winds of heaven</u> .
Daniel 8:21	And the <b>rough goat</b> is the <u>king of Grecia</u> : and the <b>great horn</b> that is between his eyes is the <b>first king</b> .
Daniel 8:22	Now that being broken, whereas four stood up for it, <b>four kingdoms</b> shall stand up out of the nation, <u>but not in his power</u> .

A.D. 493	Emperor Zeno conquered the <b>Heruli</b> by encouraging the Ostrogoths to invade them
A.D. 534	Emperor Justinian sent General Belisarius to conquer the <b>Vandals</b>
A.D. 538	General Belisarius drove the <b>Ostrogoths</b> out of Rome



Daniel 7:9	I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of His head like the pure wool: His throne was like the fiery flame, and His wheels as burning fire.
Daniel 7:10	A fiery stream issued and came forth from before Him: thousand thousands ministered unto Him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before Him: <a href="the-independent">the-independent</a> was set, and the books were opened.
Daniel 7:13	I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him.
Daniel 7:14	And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.
Hosea 13:6	According to their pasture, so were they filled; they were filled, and their heart was exalted; therefore have they forgotten Me.
Hosea 13:7	Therefore I will be unto them as a <b>lion</b> : as a <b>leopard</b> by the way <b>will</b> I <b>observe them</b> :
Hosea 13:8	I will meet them as a <b>bear</b> that is bereaved of her whelps, and will <u>rend</u> the caul of their heart, and there will I devour them like a <b>lion</b> : the <b>wild</b> beast shall tear them.
Hosea 13:9	O Israel, thou hast destroyed thyself; but in Me is thine help.

'I did not adore him, but that God who hath honored him with his high-priesthood.
