## Bible Study #7 The Creator Challenged

Matthew 24:14	And this <b>gospel of the kingdom</b> shall be <b>preached in <u>all the world</u></b> for a witness unto <u>all nations</u> ; and <i>then shall the end come</i> .
Revelation 14:6	And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the <b>everlasting gospel to preach</b> unto them that <b>dwell on the earth</b> , and to <b>every nation</b> , and <b>kindred</b> , and <b>tongue</b> , and <b>people</b> ,
Revelation 14:7	Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of His judgment is come: and worship Him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.
Revelation 14:14	And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and <b>upon the cloud one sat like unto the Son of man</b> , having on his head a golden crown, and <b>in his hand a sharp sickle</b> .

Matthew 13:39	the <u>harvest</u> is the <i>end of the world</i>

Revelation 14:8	And there <b>followed another angel</b> , saying, <b>Babylon is fallen</b> , is fallen, that great city, because <b>she made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of <u>her</u> fornication</b> .
Revelation 14:9	And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand,
Revelation 14:10	The same <b>shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God</b> , which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:
Revelation 14:11	And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who <u>worship</u> the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name.

Jeremiah 6:2	I have likened the <u>daughter of Zion</u> to a lovely and delicate <u>woman</u> .
2 Corinthians 11:2	For I am jealous for you with godly jealousy. For I have <b>betrothed you to one husband</b> , that I may present you as a <b>chaste virgin to Christ</b> .
Ephesians 5:31	For this cause shall <u>a man</u> leave his father and mother, and <b>shall be joined unto</b> <u>his wife</u> , and <u>they two shall be one flesh</u> .
Ephesians 5:32	This is a <b>great mystery</b> : but <b>I speak concerning Christ and the church</b> .
Revelation 14:7	and worship Him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.
Revelation 14:8	<u>she</u> made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of <u>her</u> fornication.
Revelation 14:9	If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand,
Revelation 14:11	and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name.
2 Thessalonians 2:4	opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or that is worshiped, so that he sits as God in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God.
Revelation 13:3	and all the world wondered after the beast.
Revelation 13:4	And <b>they <u>worshipped</u> the dragon</b> which gave power unto the beast: and <b>they <u>worshipped</u> the beast</b> , saying, Who is like unto the beast? who is able to make war with him?
Revelation 13:8	And <i>all that dwell upon the earth</i> shall <u>worship</u> him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.
Revelation 13:12	And hecauseth the earth and them which dwell therein to worship the first beast
Revelation 13:15	the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.

Revelation 4:11	Thou art worthy, O Lord, to <u>receive glory</u> and <u>honour</u> and <u>power</u> : for <u>Thou hast created</u> all things, and for Thy pleasure they are and were <u>created</u> .
Psalms 95:6	O come, <b>let us <u>worship</u></b> and <b>bow down</b> : let us <b>kneel before the LORD</b> <i>our</i> <u>Maker</u> .
Isaiah 43:21	This people I have <u>formed</u> for Myself; they shall <u>declare My praise</u> .
Psalms 100:2	Serve the Lord with gladness; come before His presence with singing.
Psalms 100:3	Know that the Lord, He is God; it is He who has made us, and not we ourselves
Nehemiah 9:6	You alone are the LORD; You have made heaven, the heaven of heavens, with all their host, the earth and everything on it, the seas and all that is in them, and You preserve them all. The host of heaven worships You.
Matthew 4:8	Again, the <b>devil</b> taketh Him up into an exceeding high mountain, and showeth Him all the <b>kingdoms of the world</b> , and the <b>glory of them</b> ;
Matthew 4:9	And saith unto Him, All these things will I give Thee, if Thou wilt fall down and worship me.
Matthew 4:10	Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and Him only shalt thou serve.
Isaiah 14:12	How you are fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! How you are cut down to the ground, you who weakened the nations!
Isaiah 14:13	For you have said in your heart: 'I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation on the farthest sides of the north;
Isaiah 14:14	I will <u>ascend above the heights</u> of the clouds, <u>I will be like the Most</u> <u>High</u> .'
2 Thessalonians 2:4	who opposes and <u>exalts himself above</u> all that is called <u>God</u> or that is worshiped, so that he <u>sits as God</u> in the temple of God, <u>showing himself</u> that he is God.

2 Peter 3:3	Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts,
2 Peter 3:4	And saying, Where is the <u>promise of his coming</u> ? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation.
2 Peter 3:5	For this <b>they</b> <i>willingly are ignorant</i> <b>of</b> , that <b>by the</b> <i>word</i> <b>of God the heavens</b> were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:
2 Peter 3:6	Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished
Isaiah 29:16	Surely <b>you have things turned around!</b> Shall the <b>potter be esteemed as the clay</b> ; For <b>shall the thing made say</b> of him who made it, " <b>He did not make me</b> "? Or <b>shall the thing formed say</b> of him who formed it, " <b>He has no understanding</b> "?
Isaiah 64:8	But now, O LORD, <b>Thou art our <u>Father</u></b> ; <b>we are the clay</b> , and <b>Thou our potter</b> ; and <b>we all are the work of Thy hand</b> .

Genesis 3:1	Now the <b>serpent</b> was <b>more cunning than any beast</b> of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the <b>woman</b> , "Has God indeed said, 'You shall not eat of every tree of the garden'?"
Matthew 4:3	Now when the <b>tempter</b> came to Him, he said, "If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread."
1 Corinthians 16:13	Watch, stand fast in the faith, be brave, be strong.
Philippians 1:27	Only let your conduct be worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of your affairs, that you <u>stand</u> <u>fast in one spirit</u> , with <b>one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel</b> ,

Hebrews 11:1	Now <u>faith is the substance</u> of things hoped for, the <u>evidence of things</u> not seen.
Hebrews 11:3	By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible.
Hebrews 11:6	But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Colossians 1:16	For <b>by Him were all things</b> <u>created</u> , that are in <b>heaven</b> , and that are in <b>earth</b> , <b>visible and invisible</b> , whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: <b>all things were</b> <u>created</u> <b>by Him</b> , and <b>for Him</b> :
Colossians 1:17	And He is before all things, and by Him all things consist.
Psalms 33:6	By the word of the LORD were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth.
Psalms 33:8	Let all the earth <b>fear the LORD</b> : let all the inhabitants of the world <b>stand</b> in awe of Him.
