There should be less preaching and more teaching {6T 87.3}

The *significance of the Jewish economy is not yet fully comprehended*. <u>Truths vast and</u> <u>profound are shadowed forth in its rites and symbols</u>. **The gospel is the key that unlocks its** *mysteries*. <u>Through a knowledge of the plan of redemption</u>, <u>its truths are opened to the</u> <u>understanding</u>. Far more than we do, <u>it is our privilege to understand</u> these wonderful themes. <u>We are to comprehend the deep things of God</u>. *Angels desire to look into the truths that are revealed to the people* who with contrite hearts are searching the word of God, and <u>praving for</u> <u>greater lengths and breadths and depths and heights of the knowledge</u> which He alone can give. {COL 133.1} Chapter 11 Things New and Old

Leviticus 16:5	And he shall take from the congregation of the children of Israel two kids of the goats as a sin offering
Leviticus 16:7	He shall take the two goats and present them before the LORD at the door of the <u>tabernacle of meeting</u>.
Leviticus 16:8	Then Aaron shall cast lots for the two goats: one lot for the LORD and the other lot for the scapegoat .
Leviticus 16:9	And Aaron shall bring the goat on which the LORD's lot fell, and offer it as a sin offering.
Leviticus 16:10	But the goat on which the lot fell to be the scapegoat shall be presented alive before the LORD, to make atonement upon it, and to let it go as the scapegoat into the wilderness.

Important truths concerning the atonement were taught the people by this yearly service. In the sin offerings presented during the year, a substitute had been accepted in the sinner's stead; but the blood of the victim had not made full atonement for the sin. It had only provided a means by which the sin was transferred to the sanctuary. By the offering of blood, the sinner acknowledged the authority of the law, confessed the guilt of his transgression, and expressed his faith in Him who was to take away the sin of the world; but he was not entirely released from the condemnation of the law. {PP 355.5 & GC 420.1}

On the Day of Atonement the high priest, having taken an offering for the congregation, went into the most holy place with the blood and sprinkled it upon the mercy seat, above the tables of the law. Thus the claims of the law, which demanded the life of the sinner, were satisfied. Then in his character of mediator the priest took the sins upon himself, and, leaving the sanctuary, he bore with him the burden of Israel's guilt. At the door of the tabernacle he laid his hands upon the head of the scapegoat and confessed over him "all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions in all their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat." And as the goat bearing these sins was sent away, they were, with him, regarded as forever separated from the people. Such was the service performed "unto the example and shadow of heavenly things." {PP 355.5 & GC 420.1}

Now it may be it is not too late. Now it may be you can repent. But <u>even if pardon is written</u> <u>against your names</u>, <u>you will sustain terrible loss</u>; for **the scars you have made upon your souls will remain**. {TM 447.1} Chapter 63

He <u>may be converted</u>; he <u>may see the wickedness</u> of his injustice to his fellowmen—and, as far as possible, <u>make restitution</u>; <u>but</u> the scars of a wounded conscience will ever remain. {1MCP 326.2} Chapter 34 Conscience

<u>The infinite value of the sacrifice required for our redemption reveals the fact that sin is a</u> <u>tremendous evil</u>. Through sin the whole human organism is deranged, the <u>mind</u> is perverted, the <u>imagination</u> corrupted. Sin has degraded the <u>faculties of the soul</u>. <u>Temptations from</u> <u>without find an answering chord within the heart</u>, and the feet turn imperceptibly toward <u>evil</u>. {MH 451.2} Chapter 38

Leviticus 16:18	And he shall go out to the altar that is before the LORD, and make atonement for it , and shall take some of the blood of the bull and some of the blood of the goat , and <u>on the horns of the altar</u> all around put it.

Jacob prevailed because he was persevering and determined. His victory is an evidence of the power of *importunate* prayer. All who will lay hold of God's promises, as he did, and be as earnest and persevering as he was, will succeed as he succeeded. Those who are unwilling to deny self, to agonize before God, to pray long and earnestly for His blessing, will not obtain it. Wrestling with God—how few know what it is! How few have ever had their <u>souls drawn out</u> after God with intensity of desire until every power is on the stretch. When waves of despair which no language can express sweep over the suppliant, <u>how few cling with unyielding faith</u> to the promises of God. {GC 621.2}

importunate = Troublesomely urgent or persistent in requesting; pressingly entreating.

Jeremiah 30:5	For thus says the Lord: We have heard a voice of trembling, of fear, and not of peace.
Jeremiah 30:6	Ask now, and see, whether a man is ever in labor with child ? So why do I see every man with his hands on his loins like a woman in labor , and all faces turned pale?

Had not Jacob previously repented of his sin in obtaining the birthright by fraud, God would not have heard his prayer and mercifully preserved his life. So, *in the time of trouble*, <u>if the</u> people of God had unconfessed sins to appear before them while tortured with fear and anguish, they would be overwhelmed; despair would cut off their faith, and they could not have confidence to plead with God for deliverance. But *while they have a deep sense of their unworthiness*, they have no concealed wrongs to reveal. Their sins have gone beforehand to judgment and have been <u>blotted out</u>, and <u>they cannot bring them to remembrance</u>. {GC 620.1} Chapter 39 The Time of Trouble

Isaiah 43:21	This people I have <u>formed</u> for Myself; they shall declare My praise.
Isaiah 43:25	I, even I, am He who <u>blots out your transgressions</u> for My own sake; and <u>I will not remember your sins</u>.
Isaiah 43:26	Put Me in remembrance; <i>let us contend together;</i> state your case, <u>that</u> you may be acquitted.

Now, while our great High Priest is making the atonement for us, we should seek to become perfect in Christ. Not even by a thought could our Saviour be brought to yield to the power of temptation. Satan finds in human hearts some point where <u>he can gain a foothold</u>; some <u>sinful</u> <u>desire is cherished</u>, <u>by means of which his temptations assert their power</u>. But Christ declared of Himself: "The prince of this world cometh, and hath nothing in Me." **Satan could find nothing in the Son of God that would enable him to gain the victory**. He had kept His Father's commandments, and there was no sin in Him that Satan could use to his advantage. <u>This is</u> <u>the condition in which those must be found who shall stand in the time of trouble</u>.

{GC 623.1} Chapter 39 The Time of Trouble

He who has **not sufficient faith** in Christ **to believe** that *He can* **keep him from sinning**, <u>has not</u> <u>the faith that will give him an entrance into the kingdom of God</u>. {RH March 10, 1904, par. 26} "Laborers Together With God"

Revelation 22:11 He that is <u>unjust</u>, **let him be unjust still**: and he which is <u>filthy</u>, **let him be filthy still**: and he that is <u>righteous</u>, **let him be righteous still**: and he that is <u>holy</u>, **let him be holy still**.

<u>Man may grow up into Christ</u>, his living head. It is <u>not the work of a moment</u>, <u>but that of a</u> <u>lifetime</u>. By growing daily in the divine life, he will **not attain to the full stature of a <u>perfect</u>** <u>man</u> in Christ until his probation ceases. {4T 366.3} Chapter 32 Religion in the Daily Life Those who are living upon the earth when <u>the intercession of Christ shall cease</u> in the sanctuary above are to stand in the sight of a holy God without a mediator. Their <u>robes must be spotless</u>, their <u>characters must be purified</u> from sin by the blood of sprinkling. <u>Through the grace of God</u> and their own <u>diligent effort they must be conquerors in the battle with evil</u>. While the investigative judgment is going forward in heaven, while the sins of penitent believers are being removed from the sanctuary, <u>there is to be a special work of purification</u>, of <u>putting</u> away of sin, among God's people upon earth... When this work shall have been accomplished, the followers of Christ will be ready for His appearing.

{GC 425.1-2} Chapter 24 In the Holy of Holies

1 John 3:3 And every man that hath <u>this hope in Him purifieth</u> himself, <u>even as He is</u> <u>pure</u>.

As the people of God <u>afflict their souls before Him</u>, <u>pleading for purity of heart</u>, the command is given, "Take away the filthy garments" from them, and the encouraging words are spoken, "Behold, I have caused thine iniquity to pass from thee, and I will clothe thee with change of raiment." <u>The spotless robe of Christ's righteousness is placed upon the tried</u>, <u>tempted</u>, <u>yet</u> <u>faithful children of God</u>. The despised remnant are clothed in glorious apparel, *nevermore to be defiled by the corruptions of the world*. Their names are retained in the Lamb's book of life, enrolled among the faithful of all ages. They have resisted the wiles of the deceiver; <u>they have</u> <u>not been turned from their loyalty by the dragon's roar</u>. {5T 475.2} Chapter 53 Joshua and the Angel

Now they are eternally secure from the tempter's devices. Their sins are transferred to the originator of sin. And the remnant are not only pardoned and accepted, but honored. "A fair miter" is set upon their heads. They are to be as kings and priests unto God. While Satan was urging his accusations and seeking to destroy this company, holy angels, unseen, were passing to and fro, placing upon them the seal of the living God. These are they that stand upon Mount Zion with the Lamb, having the Father's name written in their foreheads. They sing the new song before the throne, that song which no man can learn save the hundred and forty and four thousand, which were redeemed from the earth.

<u>We were brought into existence because we were needed</u>. How sad the thought that if we stand on the wrong side, in the ranks of the enemy, we are *lost to the design of our creation*. We are disappointing our Redeemer; the *powers He designed for His service* are used to oppose His grace and matchless love.

I saw that <u>Jesus' work in the sanctuary will soon be finished</u>. And after His work there is finished, He will come to the door of the first apartment, and confess the sins of Israel upon the head of the Scape Goat. Then <u>He will put on the garments of vengeance</u>. Then <u>the plagues will come upon the wicked</u>, and they do not come till Jesus puts on that garment, <u>and takes His place upon the great white cloud</u>. Then **while the plagues are falling**, **the Scape Goat is being led away**. *He makes a mighty struggle to escape*, but <u>he is held fast by the hand that leads</u> <u>him</u>. *If he should effect his escape*, *Israel would lose their lives*. I saw that it would take time to lead away the Scape Goat into the land of forgetfulness after the sins were put on his head. {SpM 2.1}

To His church, <u>Christ has given ample facilities</u>, that He may receive a large revenue of glory from His redeemed, purchased possession. **The church**, being <u>endowed with the righteousness</u> <u>of Christ</u>, is His depository, in which the wealth of His mercy, His love, His grace, <u>is to appear in</u> <u>full and final display</u>. The declaration in His intercessory prayer, that the Father's love is as great toward us as toward Himself, the only-begotten Son, and that we shall be with Him where He is, <u>forever one with Christ and the Father</u>, is a marvel to the heavenly host, and it is their great joy. The gift of His Holy Spirit, rich, full, and abundant, is to be to His church as <u>an</u> <u>encompassing wall of fire</u>, which the powers of hell shall not prevail against. In their untainted purity and spotless perfection, Christ looks upon His people as the reward of all His suffering, His humiliation, and His love, and the supplement of His glory— Christ, <u>the great</u> <u>center from which radiates all glory</u>. Not until he fell crippled and helpless upon the breast of the covenant angel did Jacob know the victory of conquering faith and receive the title of a prince with God. It was when he "halted upon his thigh" that the armed bands of Esau were stilled before him, and the Pharaoh, proud heir of a kingly line, stooped to crave his blessing. So **the Captain of our salvation was made** "**perfect through sufferings**," and the <u>children of faith "out of weakness were made strong</u>," and "turned to flight the armies of the aliens." So do "the lame take the prey," and the **weak become** "**as David**," and "<u>the house of David</u> … <u>as the angel of the Lord</u>." {MB 62.3} Chapter 3 The Spirituality of the Law

There are many precious truths contained in the Word of God, **but it is** "*present truth*" **that the flock needs now**. I have seen the <u>danger of the messengers running off from the important</u> <u>points of present truth</u>, to dwell upon subjects that are not calculated to unite the flock and sanctify the soul. **Satan will here take every possible advantage to injure the cause**. {EW 63.1}

But such subjects as the **sanctuary**, **in connection with the 2300 days**, the **commandments of God** and the **faith of Jesus**, are perfectly calculated to <u>explain the past Advent movement</u> and show what <u>our present position</u> is, <u>establish the faith of the doubting</u>, and <u>give certainty</u> to the glorious future. These, I have frequently seen, were the <u>principal subjects on which the</u> <u>messengers should dwell</u>. {EW 63.2}
