John 1:14                      And **the Word became *flesh* and dwelt among us**, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

Galatians 4:4                But *when the fullness of the time had come*, God sent forth His Son, **born of a woman, born under the law**,

Galatians 4:5                **to redeem those who were under the law**, that we might receive the adoption as sons...

Hebrews 2:14                Forasmuch then **as the children are partakers of *flesh and blood*, He also Himself likewise took part of the same...**

Hebrews 2:16                For verily He took not on him the nature of angels; but **He took on him the seed of Abraham**.

Hebrews 2:17                Wherefore in all things it behoved Him to be **made like unto his brethren**, that He might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people.

Hebrews 2:18                For in that **He Himself hath suffered being tempted**, He is able to succour them that are tempted.

Leviticus 22:20              Whatever has **a defect, you shall not offer**, for it shall not be acceptable on your behalf.

Leviticus 22:21              And whoever offers a sacrifice of a peace offering to the LORD, to fulfill his vow, or a freewill offering from the cattle or the sheep, **it must be perfect to be accepted**; there shall be **no defect** in it.

Leviticus 22:22              Those that are **blind or broken or maimed**, or have an **ulcer or eczema or scabs**, you shall not offer to the LORD, nor make an offering by fire of them on the altar to the LORD.

Exodus 12:5	Your <b>lamb shall be without blemish</b> , a male of the first year. You may take it from the sheep or from the goats.
1 Peter 1:18	knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers,
1 Peter 1:19	but with the precious blood of <b>Christ</b> , as of a <b>lamb without blemish and without spot</b> .
1 Peter 1:20	He indeed was <u>foreordained before the foundation of the world</u> , but was <i><b>manifest</b> in these last times for you</i>

Leviticus 21:17	Speak to Aaron, saying: ' <u>No man</u> of your descendants in succeeding generations, <u>who has <b>any defect</b></u> , <u>may approach to offer the bread of his God</u> .
Leviticus 21:18	For <u>any man who has <b>a defect</b></u> <u>shall not approach</u> : a man <b>blind</b> or <b>lame</b> , who has a <b>marred face</b> or <b>any limb too long</b> ,
Leviticus 21:19	a man who has a <b>broken foot</b> or <b>broken hand</b> ,
Leviticus 21:20	or is a <b>hunchback</b> or a <b>dwarf</b> , or a man who has a <b>defect in his eye</b> , or <b>eczema</b> or <b>scab</b> , or is a <b>eunuch</b> .
Leviticus 21:21	<u>No man</u> of the descendants of Aaron the priest, <u>who has <b>a defect</b></u> , <u>shall come near to offer the offerings made by fire to the LORD</u> . He has a <b>defect</b> ; he <u>shall not come near</u> to offer the bread of his God.

- Hebrews 4:14      Seeing then that we have a great **High Priest**, that is passed into the heavens, **Jesus the Son of God**, let us hold fast our profession.
- Hebrews 4:15      For we have not an **High Priest** which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet **without sin**.
- Hebrews 4:16      Let us therefore *come boldly unto the throne of grace*, that we may *obtain mercy, and find grace* to help in time of need.
- Hebrews 7:26      For such an **High Priest** *became us*, who is **holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners**, and made higher than the heavens
- John 19:6          Therefore, when the chief priests and officers saw Him, they cried out, saying, "Crucify Him, crucify Him!" **Pilate said** to them, "You take Him and crucify Him, for **I find no fault in Him**."

Exodus 29:38      Now this is what you shall **offer on the altar**: two **lambs** of the first year, **day by day continually**.

**Continually** H8548 constant regular **daily** always continual perpetual ever

Leviticus 1:3      ...he [**the sinner**] shall **offer it of his own free will at the door of the tabernacle of meeting** before the LORD.

Leviticus 1:4      Then he shall **put his hand on the head** of the burnt offering, and **it will be accepted on his behalf to make atonement for him**.

Leviticus 1:5      **He shall kill [it] before the LORD**; and the **priests**, Aaron's sons, shall bring the blood and **sprinkle the blood all around on the altar...**

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that **He gave His only begotten Son**, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

2 Corinthians 5:21 For **He made Him** who knew no sin **to be sin for us**, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

Romans 6:23 For the **wages of sin is death**; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

1 John 2:2 And **He is the propitiation** for our sins: and not for ours only, but also **for the sins of the whole world**.

Hebrews 7:9 And as I may so say, **Levi** also, who receiveth tithes, **payed tithes in Abraham**.

Hebrews 7:10 For **he was yet in the loins of his father**, when **Melchisedek** met him.

Colossians 1:16 For **by Him were all things created...all things were created by Him**, and **for Him**:

Colossians 1:17 And **He is before all things**, and **by Him all things consist**.

Hebrews 2:9 But we see **Jesus**, who was **made** a little lower than the angels **for the suffering of death**, crowned with glory and honor; that He by the grace of God should **taste death for every man**.

Exodus 40:30      [Moses] set the **laver between the tabernacle of meeting and the altar,** and **put water there for washing.**

Titus 3:5      ...according to His mercy **He saved us, *through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit***

Ephesians 5:26      that He might **sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word,**

Ephesians 5:27      that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish.



Colossians 2:12      ***buried with Him in baptism***, in which you also were ***raised with Him through faith*** in the working of **God**, who **raised Him from the dead**.

Acts 22:16      And now why are you waiting? Arise and **be baptized**, and **wash away your sins**, calling on the name of the Lord.

Acts 2:38      Then Peter said to them, "**Repent**, and let every one of you **be baptized** in the name of Jesus Christ **for the remission of sins**; and you shall **receive the gift of the Holy Spirit**.

John 7:37      On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "**If anyone thirsts**, let him **come to Me and drink**.

John 7:38      He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow **rivers of living water**."

John 7:39      But this **He spoke concerning the Spirit**, whom **those believing in Him would receive...**

John 6:63      It is the **Spirit who gives life**; the flesh profits nothing. The **words that I speak to you are spirit**, and they **are life**.

John 4:13      Jesus answered and said to her, "Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again,

John 4:14      but **whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst**. But **the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life**."

Romans 6:9            Knowing that **Christ** being **raised from the dead** *dieth no more*; death hath no more dominion over Him.

Romans 6:10           For in that He died, **He died unto sin once: but in that He liveth, He liveth unto God**.

Romans 6:14           For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are **not under the law**, but ***under grace***.

Acts 5:31              **Him God has exalted** to His right hand to be Prince and Savior, ***to give repentance*** to Israel and **forgiveness of sins**.

Proverbs 28:13        He who ***covers his sins will not prosper***, but **whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy**.

Romans 4:25           Who was **delivered for our offenses**, and was **raised again for our justification**.

---

1 Corinthians 15:3     For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that **Christ died for our sins** according to the Scriptures,

1 Corinthians 15:4     and that **He was buried**, and that **He rose again** the third day according to the Scriptures,

1 Corinthians 15:17    And if **Christ is not risen**, **your faith is futile; you are still in your sins!**

1 Corinthians 15:18    Then **also those who have fallen asleep in Christ** have perished.

1 Corinthians 15:19    *If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men the most pitiable.*

Romans 5:10           For if, when we were enemies, **we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son**, *much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life*.

Leviticus 17:11      For the life of the flesh **is in the blood**, and ***I have given it to you*** upon the altar to make **atonement for your souls**; for it is the blood that **makes atonement** for the soul.

Psalms 51:10      **Create** in me a clean heart, O God; and **renew** a right spirit within me.

Titus 3:5      ...according to His mercy **He saved us, *through the washing of regeneration and renewing*** of the Holy Spirit

John 3:5      Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.

John 3:6      That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and **that which is born of the Spirit is spirit**.

John 3:7      Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be born again.'

1 Corinthians 15:22      For as in Adam all die, even so **in Christ all shall be made alive**.
