
The Great Advent Awakening 1840-1844



Exodus 25:9 According to all that <u>I show you</u>, that is, the <u>pattern of the tabernacle</u> and the <u>pattern of all its furnishings</u>, just so you shall make it.

Daniel 12:12 Blessed is he that <u>waiteth</u>, and cometh to the <u>thousand three hundred</u> and five and thirty days.

Hebrews 8:1	Now <b>of the things which we have spoken this is the sum</b> : <b>We have such an high priest</b> , who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty <i>in the heavens;</i>
Hebrews 8:2	A <b>minister of the sanctuary</b> , and of the <i>true tabernacle</i> , which the <u>Lord</u> pitched, and not man.
Hebrews 8:3	For every high priest is ordained to offer gifts and sacrifices: wherefore it is of necessity that this Man have somewhat also to offer.
Hebrews 8:4	For if He were <b>on earth</b> , He should not be a priest, seeing that there are priests that offer gifts according to the law:
Hebrews 8:5	Who <b>serve unto the <u>example and shadow</u> of <i>heavenly things</i>, as Moses was admonished of God when he was about to make the tabernacle: for, See, saith He, that thou <b>make all things</b> <u>according to the pattern</u> showed to thee in the mount.</b>
Hebrews 9:1	Then verily the first covenant had also ordinances of divine service, and a <b>worldly sanctuary</b> .
Hebrews 9:2	For there was a <b>tabernacle made</b> ; the <b>first</b> , wherein was the <b>candlestick</b> , and the <b>showbread</b> ; which is <b>called the sanctuary</b> .
Hebrews 9:3	And <b>after the second veil</b> , the tabernacle which is <b>called the <u>Holiest of</u> all</b> ;
Hebrews 9:4	Which had the <b>golden censer</b> , and the <u>ark of the covenant</u> overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the <b>golden pot</b> that had <b>manna</b> , and Aaron's rod that budded, and the <b>tables of the covenant</b> ;
Hebrews 9:5	And over it the <b>cherubims of glory shadowing the mercy seat</b> ; of which we cannot now speak particularly.

Hebrews 9:6	Now when these things were thus ordained, the priests went always into the first tabernacle, accomplishing the service of God.
Hebrews 9:7	But <b>into the second went the high priest alone</b> <u>once</u> every year, not without blood, which he offered for himself, and <b>for the errors of the</b> <b>people</b> :
Hebrews 9:8	The Holy Ghost this signifying, that the way into the holiest of all was not yet made manifest, while as the first tabernacle was yet standing:
Hebrews 9:9	Which was <u>a figure for the time then present</u> , in which were offered both gifts and sacrifices, that could not make him that did the service perfect, as pertaining to the conscience;
Hebrews 9:10	Which stood only in meats and drinks, and divers washings, and carnal ordinances, imposed on them until the time of reformation.
Hebrews 9:11	But Christ being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, <u>not made with hands</u> , that is to say, not of this building;
Hebrews 9:12	Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but <b>by His own blood He</b> entered in <u>once into the holy place</u> , having obtained eternal redemption for us.
Hebrews 9:13	For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh:
Hebrews 9:14	How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, <b>purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God</b> ?

Hebrews 9:23	It was therefore necessary that the <b>patterns of things in the heavens</b> should be <i>purified</i> with these; but the <u>heavenly things themselves with</u> <u>better sacrifices</u> than these.
Hebrews 9:24	For <b>Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands</b> , which are the <b>figures of the true</b> ; <b>but <i>into heaven itself</i></b> , now to appear in the p resence of God for us:
Hebrews 9:25	Nor yet that He should offer Himself often, as the high priest entereth into the holy place every year with blood of others;
Hebrews 9:26	For then must He often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but <b>now <u>once</u> in the end of the world hath He appeared to <u>put away sin</u> by the sacrifice of Himself.</b>
Hebrews 9:27	And as it is <b>appointed unto <i>men</i> <u>once</u> to die</b> , but <b>after this <u>the judgment</u>:</b>
Hebrews 9:28	So <u>Christ</u> was <u>once</u> offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for Him <u>shall</u> He <u>appear the second time</u> without sin unto salvation.
Hebrews 9:7	But <b>into the second went the high priest alone</b> <u>once every year</u> , not without blood, which he offered for himself, and <b>for the errors of the</b> <b>people</b> :
Revelation 10:1	And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a <u>rainbow</u> was upon his head, and his face was as it were the sun, and his <u>feet as pillars of fire</u> :
Revelation 4:3	And <b>He that sat [on the throne]</b> was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and there was a <u>rainbow</u> round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald.
Revelation 1:13	And in the midst of the seven candlesticks One like unto the <b>Son of</b> Man
Revelation 1:15	And <b>His <u>feet</u> like unto fine brass, <u>as if they burned in a furnace</u></b>
Revelation 1:16	<i>His countenance was as the sun</i> shineth in its strength.



Isaiah 28:10	For <b>precept <i>must be</i> upon precept</b> , precept upon precept, <b>Line upon</b> line, line upon line, <u>Here a little</u> , and <u>there a little</u> .
Revelation 10:2	And he had <b>in his hand a little book <u>open</u>:</b> and he set his <b>right <u>foot upon</u> the <u>sea</u> and his <b>left <u>foot on</u> the <u>earth</u>,</b></b>
Isaiah 17:12	Woe to the <b>multitude of <u>many people</u></b> , which make a noise like the <b>noise</b> <b>of the <u>seas</u></b> ; and to the <b>rushing of <u>nations</u></b> , that make a rushing like the <b>rushing of <u>mighty waters</u></b> !
Revelation 13:11	And I beheld another <b>beast coming up out of the <u>earth</u>; and he <b>had two</b> horns like a lamb, and he spake as a dragon.</b>
Revelation 10:2	And he had <b>in his hand a little book <u>open</u>:</b> and he set his <b>right <u>foot upon</u> the <u>sea</u> and his <b>left <u>foot on</u> the <u>earth</u>,</b></b>
Ephesians 1:21	Far <u>above all</u> principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:
Ephesians 1:22	And hath put <b>all things <u>under His feet</u>,</b> and gave <b>Him to be the <u>head over</u> <u>all things</u> to the church</b>

Revelation 10:3	And cried with a loud voice, as when a <u>lion</u> roareth: and when he had cried, <u>seven thunders</u> uttered their <u>voices</u> .
Revelation 5:1	And I saw <u>in the right hand</u> of Him that sat on the throne <u>a book</u> written within and on the backside, <u>sealed</u> with seven seals.
Revelation 5:2	And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, <i>Who is worthy to</i> <i>open the book</i> , and <i>to <u>loose the seals</u> thereof?</i>
Revelation 5:3	And <u>no man in heaven</u> , <u>nor in earth</u> , <u>neither under the earth</u> , <u>was able to</u> <u>open the book</u> , neither to look thereon.
Revelation 10:3	And cried with a loud voice, as when <b>a <u>lion</u> roareth</b> : and when he had cried, <b>seven thunders uttered their <u>voices</u>.</b>
Revelation 5:4	And I wept much, because <b>no man was found worthy to <u>open</u> and to</b> <b>read <u>the book</u>, neither to look thereon.</b>
Revelation 5:5	And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the <u>Lion of the</u> <u>tribe of Judah</u> , the <u>Root of David</u> , hath prevailed to <u>open the book</u> , and to loose the seven seals thereof.
Revelation 5:6	And <b>I beheld</b> , and, lo, <b>in the midst of the throne</b> and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood <b>a <u>Lamb</u> as it had been</b> <u>slain</u>
Revelation 10:4	And when the <u>seven thunders</u> had uttered their <u>voices</u> , I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, <u>Seal up those</u> <u>things which the seven thunders uttered</u> , and <u>write them not</u> .
Psalms 29:3	The <b>voice of the LORD</b> is over the waters; The <b>God of glory <u>thunders</u></b>
Psalms 18:13	The <b>LORD <u>thundered</u> from heaven</b> , And the <b>Most High uttered <u>His</u> <u>voice</u></b>

Revelation 10:5	And the angel which I saw stand upon the sea and upon the earth lifted up his hand to heaven,
Revelation 10:6	And swore by <u>Him</u> that liveth for ever and ever, who <u>created heaven</u> , and the things that therein are, and <u>the earth</u> , and the things that therein are, and <u>the sea</u> , and the things which are therein, that <u>there should be</u> <u>time no longer</u> :
Exodus 20:11	For in six days the <u>LORD made heaven and earth</u> , <u>the sea</u> , and all that in them is, and <b>rested the</b> <i>seventh day</i> : wherefore the LORD <b>blessed the</b> <i>sabbath day</i> , and hallowed it.
Revelation 10:7	But in the days of the voice of the <u>seventh angel</u> , <b>when he shall <u>begin to</u></b> <u>sound</u> , the <u>mystery of God</u> should be <u>finished</u> , as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.
Revelation 11:18	And the <b>nations were angry</b> , and <u>Thy wrath is come</u> , and the <u>time of the</u> <u>dead</u> , that <u>they should be judged</u> , and that Thou shouldest give <u>reward</u> <b>unto Thy servants</b> the prophets, and to the <b>saints</b> , and <b>them that fear Thy name</b> , small and great; and shouldest <u>destroy</u> them which destroy the earth.

Revelation 11:18	And the <b>nations were angry</b> , and <b>Thy wrath is come</b> , and the <u>time of the</u> <u>dead</u> , that <u>they should be judged</u>
Amos 3:8	<b>The <u>lion</u> hath <u>roared</u>, who will not fear? <b>the Lord <u>GOD</u> hath <u>spoken</u></b>, who can but <u>prophesy</u>?</b>
Matthew 26:19	So the disciples did as Jesus had directed them; and <b>they prepared the <u>Passover</u></b> .

Matthew 28:6	He is not here; for <u>He is risen</u> "
1 Corinthians 15:20	But now <u>Christ is</u> risen from the dead, and has become <u>the firstfruits</u> of those who have fallen asleep.
Acts 2:1	When the <b>Day of Pentecost</b> had fully come, they were <b>all with one</b> accord in one place.



Daniel 7:9	I beheld till the <b>thrones were cast down</b> , and the <b>Ancient of days did sit</b> , whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: <b>His throne</b> was like the fiery flame, and <b>His wheels</b> as burning fire.
