Genesis 2:7	And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and <b>breathed into his nostrils</b> the <u>breath</u> of life; and man <i>became a living soul</i> .
Job 33:4	The <u>Spirit</u> of God hath made me, and the <u>breath</u> of the Almighty hath <i>given me life</i> .
Job 27:3	All the while my <u>breath</u> is in me, and the <u>Spirit</u> of God is in my nostrils.
Job 27:4	My lips shall <b>not speak wickedness, nor</b> my tongue utter <b>deceit</b> .
Proverbs 20:27	The <u>spirit</u> of a man is the lamp of the LORD, <i>searching all the inner depths of his heart</i> .
John 1:4	<b>In Him was life</b> ; and the life was the <b>light of men</b> .

Ecclesiastes 3:19	For that which befalleth the sons of men befalleth beasts; even one thing befalleth them: as the one dieth, so dieth the other; yea, <b>they have all one <u>breath</u></b> ; so that a <i>man hath no preeminence</i> above a beast: for all is vanity.
James 2:26	For as the <b>body without the <u>spirit</u> is dead</b> , so faith without works is dead also.
Ecclesiastes 12:7	Then shall the <b>dust return to the earth as it was</b> : and the <u>spirit</u> shall <b>return unto God</b> who gave it.
Psalms 146:4	His <u>breath</u> goeth forth, he returneth to his earth; in that very day <i>his thoughts perish</i>

James 4:14	whereas you do not know what will happen tomorrow. For what is <b>your life</b> ? It is even a <i>vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away</i> .
Job 7:7	O remember that <b>my life is <u>wind</u></b> : mine eye shall no more see good.
Job 7:9	As the <i>cloud</i> is consumed and vanisheth away: <i>so he that goeth down to the grave shall come up no more</i> .
Job 7:10	He shall <b>return no more to his house, neither shall his place know him any more</b> .

- Ecclesiastes 9:5 For the living know that they shall die: but **the dead know not any thing**, neither have they any more a reward; for the **memory of them is forgotten**.
- Ecclesiastes 9:6 ***Also their love***, and their **hatred**, and their **envy, is now perished**; **neither have they any more a portion for ever in any thing that is done under the sun**.
- Ecclesiastes 9:10 Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do it with thy might; for **there is no work**, nor **device**, nor **knowledge**, nor **wisdom, in the grave**, whither thou goest.

- Psalms 6:5 For **in death there is no remembrance** of Thee: **in the grave** who shall give Thee thanks?
- Psalms 30:9 What profit is there in my blood, when **I go down to the pit**? **Shall the dust praise Thee?** shall it **declare Thy truth**?
- Psalms 88:10 Wilt Thou **show wonders to the dead**? shall the **dead arise and praise** Thee? Selah.
- Psalms 88:11 Shall Thy **lovingkindness be declared in the grave**? or Thy faithfulness in **destruction**?
- Psalms 88:12 Shall Thy wonders be known **in the dark**? and Thy righteousness in the **land of forgetfulness**?
- 

- Psalms 115:17 The **dead praise not** the LORD, neither **any that go down into silence**.
- Isaiah 38:18 For the **grave cannot praise** Thee, **death can not celebrate** Thee: they that go down into the **pit cannot hope** for Thy truth.
- Isaiah 38:19 The living, **the living**, he **shall praise** Thee, **as I do** this day: the father to the children shall make known Thy truth.

Job 14:12                      So **man lieth down**, and **riseth not**: *till the heavens be no more*, they shall **not awake**, nor be raised out of their **sleep**.

Psalms 13:3                      Consider and hear me, O LORD my God: lighten mine eyes, lest I **sleep** the **sleep of death**

John 11:11                      These things He said, and after that He said to them, "Our friend **Lazarus sleeps**, but I go that **I may wake him up**."

John 11:12                      Then His disciples said, "Lord, if he sleeps he will get well."

John 11:13                      However, **Jesus spoke of his death**, but they thought that He was speaking about taking rest in sleep.

John 11:14                      Then ***Jesus said to them plainly***, "**Lazarus is dead**."

Acts 7:59                      And they **stoned Stephen**, calling upon God, and saying, Lord Jesus, ***receive my spirit***.

Acts 7:60                      And he kneeled down, and cried with a loud voice, Lord, lay not this sin to their charge. And when he had said this, **he fell asleep**.

1 Kings 2:10                      So **David slept with his fathers**, and **was buried** in the city of David.

Acts 2:29                      Men and brethren, let me speak freely to you of the patriarch **David**, that he is **both dead and buried**, and his **tomb is with us to this day**.

Acts 2:34                      For **David did not ascend into the heavens...**

Psalms 17:15                      As for me, **I will behold Thy face** in righteousness: I shall be satisfied, **when I awake**, with Thy likeness.

- Isaiah 26:19      **Your dead shall live**; together with my **dead body they shall arise. Awake** and sing, you **who dwell in dust**; for your dew is like the dew of herbs, and the **earth shall cast out the dead**.
- John 6:40      And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have everlasting life; and **I will raise him up at the last day**.
- John 6:44      No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and **I will raise him up at the last day**.
- John 11:23      Jesus said to her, "**Your brother will rise again.**"
- John 11:24      Martha said to Him, "I know that he **will rise again in the resurrection at the last day**."
- John 11:25      Jesus said to her, "***I am the resurrection and the life***. He who believes in Me, **though he may die, he shall live.**"
- 
- 1 Corinthians 15:20      But now **Christ is risen from the dead**, and has become the firstfruits of those who have **fallen asleep**.
- 1 Corinthians 15:21      For since by man came death, by Man also came the **resurrection of the dead**.
- 1 Corinthians 15:22      For as in Adam ***all die***, even so in Christ **all shall be made alive**.
- 1 Corinthians 15:23      But each one in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, afterward those who are Christ's **at His coming**.
- Job 19:26      And though ***after*** my skin ***worms destroy this body***, yet **in my flesh shall I see God**

- 1 Corinthians 15:51 Behold, I tell you a mystery: ***We shall not all sleep***, but we shall all be changed--
- 1 Corinthians 15:52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, **at the last trumpet**. For the trumpet will sound, and the **dead will be raised incorruptible**, and we shall be changed.
- 1 Corinthians 15:53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this **mortal must put on immortality**.
- 1 Corinthians 15:54 So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this **mortal has put on immortality**, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: **"Death is swallowed up in victory."**
- 1 Corinthians 15:55 "O Death, where is your sting? O Hades, where is your victory?"
- 

- 1 Thessalonians 4:15 For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that **we who are alive** and remain **until the coming of the Lord** will ***by no means precede those who are asleep***.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:16 For the **Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout**, with the **voice of the archangel**, and with the **trumpet of God**. And **the dead in Christ will rise first**.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:17 Then **we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air**. ***And thus we shall always be with the Lord.***
- 

- John 14:1 Let not your heart be troubled; you **believe in God, believe also in Me**.
- John 14:2 In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. **I go to prepare a place for you**.
- John 14:3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, **I will come again and receive you to Myself**; that ***where I am, there you may be also***.

- Revelation 22:12 And, behold, **I come quickly**; and **My reward is with me**, to give every man according as his work shall be.
- Matthew 16:27 For the **Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels**, and **then He will reward each** according to his works.
- 2 Timothy 4:8 Henceforth there is **laid up for me a crown** of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, **shall give me at that day**; and not to me only, but unto all **them also that love His appearing**.
- 

- Acts 1:9 Now when He had spoken these things, while they watched, **He was taken up**, and a **cloud received Him** out of their sight.
- Acts 1:10 And while they looked steadfastly toward heaven as He went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel,
- Acts 1:11 who also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? **This same Jesus**, who was **taken up from you into heaven**, **will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven**."
- 1 Thessalonians 4:17 **...in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air**. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.

- Matthew 24:27 For as the **lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west**, ***so also will the coming of the Son of Man be***.
- Matthew 24:30 Then the **sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven**, and then **all the tribes of the earth** will mourn, and they **will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory**.
- Matthew 24:31 And He will send His angels with a **great sound of a trumpet**, and they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

Revelation 1:7 Behold, **He cometh with clouds**; and **every eye shall see Him**, and they also which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.

Mark 14:62 Jesus said, "I am. And **you will see the Son of Man** sitting at the right hand of the Power, and **coming with the clouds of heaven.**"

Matthew 26:64 Jesus said to him, "It is as you said. Nevertheless, I say to you, hereafter **you will see the Son of Man** sitting at the right hand of the Power, and **coming on the clouds of heaven.**"

Psalms 50:3 Our **God shall come**, and shall **not keep silence**: a **fire shall devour before Him**, and it shall be **very tempestuous round about Him**.

Psalms 50:4 He shall **call to the heavens** from above, and **to the earth**, that he may judge His people.

Psalms 50:5 **Gather my saints together unto Me**; those that have made a covenant with Me by sacrifice.

Psalms 50:6 And the **heavens shall declare** His righteousness: for God is judge Himself.

2 Thessalonians 1:7 and to give you who are troubled rest with us when the **Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with His mighty angels**,

2 Thessalonians 1:8 in **flaming fire taking vengeance** on those who do not know God, and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Revelation 6:14	And the <b><u>heaven departed as a scroll</u></b> when it is rolled together; and <b>every mountain and island were moved out of their places.</b>
Revelation 6:15	And the <b>kings of the earth</b> , and the <b>great men</b> , and the <b>rich men</b> , and the <b>chief captains</b> , and the <b>mighty men</b> , and <b>every bondman</b> , and <b>every free man</b> , <b><u>hid themselves</u></b> in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;
Revelation 6:16	And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and <b><u>hide us from the face of Him</u></b> that sitteth on the throne, and <b>from the wrath</b> of the Lamb:
Revelation 6:17	For the <b>great day of His wrath is come</b> ; and who shall be able to stand?
Job 14:12	So man lieth down, and riseth not: <b><u>till the heavens be no more</u></b> , they shall <b><u>not awake</u></b> , nor be raised out of their <b><u>sleep</u></b> .

Matthew 13:30	Let <b>both grow together until the harvest</b> , and at the <b>time of harvest</b> I will say to the reapers, "First gather together the <b>tares</b> and bind them in bundles to burn them, but gather the <b>wheat</b> into my barn."
Matthew 13:39	<b><u>...the harvest is the end of the world...</u></b>
Matthew 25:31	When the <b>Son of Man comes in His glory</b> , and <b>all the holy angels with Him</b> , then He will sit on the throne of His glory.
Matthew 25:32	<b>All the nations will be gathered before Him</b> , and <b>He will separate them one from another</b> , as a shepherd divides <b>his sheep from the goats</b> .

Matthew 24:37	But <b>as the days of Noah were</b> , <b><i>so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.</i></b>
Matthew 24:38	For as in the days <b>before the flood</b> , <b><u>they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark,</u></b>
Matthew 24:39	<b>and did not know until the flood came and <u>took them all away,</u></b> <b><i>so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.</i></b>
Revelation 3:10	Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will <b><u>keep thee from the hour of temptation</u></b> , which shall come upon all the world, to <b>try them</b> that dwell upon the earth.
John 17:15	I pray <b>not</b> that thou shouldest <b><i>take them out of the world</i></b> , but that thou shouldest <b><u>keep them from the evil</u></b> .



Luke 23:43                      And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, **To day shalt thou be with me in paradise.**

John 20:17                     Jesus said to her, "Do not cling to Me, for **I have not yet ascended to My Father**; but go to My brethren and say to them, '**I am ascending to My Father** and your Father, and to My God and your God.' "

Revelation 6:9	...I saw <b>under the altar the souls of them that were slain</b> for the word of God, and for the <b>testimony which they held:</b>
Revelation 6:10	And they <b><u>cried with a loud voice,</u></b> saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?

Genesis 2:16	And the Lord God commanded the man, saying, "Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat;
Genesis 2:17	but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for <b>in the day that you eat of it <u>you shall surely die.</u></b> "
Genesis 3:4	Then the serpent said to the woman, " <b><u>You will not surely die.</u></b>
Genesis 3:5	For God knows that in the day you eat of it <b>your eyes will be opened, and <u>you will be like God,</u></b> knowing good and evil."
Romans 1:25	who <b><u>exchanged the truth of God for the lie,</u></b> and <b><u>worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator,</u></b> who is blessed forever. Amen.

Ezekiel 18:4	Behold, <b>all souls are Mine;</b> as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the <b><u>soul that sinneth,</u></b> it <b><u>shall die.</u></b>
1 Timothy 6:15	which He will manifest in His own time, He who is <b>the blessed and only <u>Potentate,</u></b> the <b><u>King of kings</u></b> and <b><u>Lord of lords,</u></b>
1 Timothy 6:16	<b><u>who alone has immortality,</u></b> dwelling in unapproachable light, whom <b>no man has seen or can see,</b> to whom be honor and everlasting power. Amen.

- Leviticus 20:6 ...the **person who turns to mediums and familiar spirits**, to prostitute himself with them, **I will set My face against** that person and **cut him off** from his people.
- 1 Chronicles 10:13 So **Saul died for his unfaithfulness** which he had committed against the Lord, because **he did not keep the word of the Lord**, and also because **he consulted a medium for guidance**.
- 1 Chronicles 10:14 But he did **not inquire of the Lord**; **therefore He killed him**, and turned the kingdom over to David the son of Jesse.

- 1 Peter 3:18 For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened ***by the Spirit***:
- 1 Peter 3:19 **By which also He went and preached unto the spirits in prison**;
- 1 Peter 3:20 Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited **in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing**, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water.
- Genesis 6:3 And the LORD said, ***My Spirit shall not always strive with man***, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years.

1 Peter 3:19      **By which also He went and preached unto the spirits in prison**

Psalm 142:7      Bring my **soul out of prison**, that I may praise Thy name: the righteous shall compass me about; for Thou shalt deal bountifully with me.

Isaiah 42:7      To open the blind eyes, to **bring out the prisoners from the prison**, and them that **sit in darkness out of the prison house**.

Isaiah 61:1      The ***Spirit of the Lord GOD*** is upon Me; because the LORD hath anointed Me to **preach good tidings** unto the meek; He hath sent Me to **bind up the brokenhearted**, to **proclaim liberty to the captives**, and the **opening of the prison to them that are bound**

1 Peter 3:19      **By which also He went and preached unto the spirits in prison**

2 Peter 2:19      While they ***promise them liberty***, they themselves are the **servants of corruption**: for of whom a **man is overcome**, of the same is he **brought in bondage**.

John 8:32      And ye shall know the truth, and the **truth shall make you free**.

John 8:33      They answered Him, We be Abraham's seed, and were never in bondage to any man: how sayest thou, Ye shall be made free?

John 8:34      Jesus answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, **Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin**.

1 Peter 3:19      **By which also He went and preached unto the spirits in prison**

Romans 7:23      But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and **bringing me into captivity to the law of sin** which is in my members.

Romans 8:15      For the law of the **Spirit of life in Christ Jesus** hath **made me free from the law of sin** and death.

Luke 16:19	There was a certain <b>rich man</b> , which was clothed in purple and fine linen, and fared sumptuously every day:
Luke 16:20	And there was a certain beggar named <b>Lazarus</b> , which was laid at his gate, full of sores,
Luke 16:21	And desiring to be fed with the <b>crumbs which fell from the rich man's table</b> : moreover the dogs came and licked his sores.
Luke 16:22	And it came to pass, that the <b>beggar died</b> , and was <u>carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom</u> : the <b>rich man</b> also <b>died</b> , and was <u>buried</u> ;
Matthew 13:39	...the <b>harvest is the end of the world</b> ; and the <u>reapers are the angels</u> .
Matthew 13:40	As therefore the tares are <u>gathered</u> and burned in the fire; <b>so shall it be in the end of this world</b> .
<hr/>	
Luke 16:23	And in <u>hell</u> he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth <b>Abraham</b> afar off, and <b>Lazarus in his bosom</b> .
Luke 16:24	And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the <b>tip of his finger in water</b> , and <b>cool my tongue</b> ; for I am tormented in this flame.
Luke 16:25	But Abraham said, Son, remember that thou <b>in thy lifetime receivedst thy good things</b> , and <b>likewise Lazarus evil things</b> : but now he is comforted, and thou art tormented.
Luke 16:26	And beside all this, <b>between us and you there is a great gulf fixed</b> : so that they which would <b>pass from hence to you cannot</b> ; <b>neither can they pass to us</b> , that would come from thence.

- Luke 16:27      Then he said, I pray thee therefore, father, that thou wouldest **send *him* to my father's house**:
- Luke 16:28      For I have five brethren; that he may testify unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment.
- Luke 16:29      Abraham saith unto him, **They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them.**
- Luke 16:30      And he said, Nay, father Abraham: but if ***one went unto them from the dead***, they will repent.
- Luke 16:31      And he said unto him, **If they hear not Moses and the prophets**, neither will they be persuaded, ***though one rose from the dead.***
