## Thy Way, O God Part 2

## Psalms 77:13 Thy way, O God, is in the sanctuary: who is so great a God as our God?



Leviticus 6:13	A <b>fire</b> shall <u>always</u> be <b>burning on the altar</b> ; it shall <i>never go out</i> .

Exodus 28:29 So Aaron shall **bear the names of the sons of Israel** on the breastplate of <u>judgment</u> **over his heart**, when he goes **into the holy place**, as a memorial **before the LORD** <u>continually</u>.

- Romans 8:33 Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is **God that** justifieth.
- Romans 8:34 Who is *he that condemneth*? It is **Christ** *that died*, yea rather, that *is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God*, who also **maketh intercession for us**.
- Hebrews 7:25Wherefore He is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto<br/>God by Him, seeing He ever liveth to make intercession for them.
- 1 John 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, *that ye sin not*. And **if** any man sin, <u>we have an advocate with the Father</u>, Jesus Christ the righteous



Exodus 30:1	You shall make an altar to burn incense on

Exodus 30:7	Aaron shall <b>burn</b> on it <b>sweet</b> incense every morning; when he tends the
	lamps, he shall <b>burn <u>incense</u> on it</b> .

Exodus 30:8 And when Aaron lights the lamps <u>at twilight</u>, he shall **burn** <u>incense</u> on it, a <u>perpetual incense</u> before the LORD throughout your generations.

Exodus 30:36 And you shall beat some of it very fine, and put some of it <u>before the</u> <u>Testimony in the tabernacle of meeting</u> where I will meet with you. It shall be most holy to you.

Exodus 30:35 You shall make of these an <u>incense</u>, a compound according to the art of the perfumer, salted, pure, and <u>holy</u>.

Exodus 30:37 But as for the <u>incense</u> which you shall make, you shall not make any for yourselves, according to its composition. It <u>shall be to you holy</u> for the LORD.

Revelation 8:3	And another angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden censer; and there was given unto him <u>much incense</u> , that he should <b>offer it with</b> <b>the</b> <u>prayers of all saints</u> upon the golden altar which was before the throne.
Revelation 8:4	And the <b>smoke of the <u>incense</u>, which came with the <u>prayers of the</u> <u>saints</u>, ascended up before God out of the angel's hand.</b>
Psalms 141:2	Let my <b>prayer</b> be <b>set forth before thee</b> <u>as incense</u> ; and the <u>lifting up of</u> <u>my hands</u> as the evening sacrifice.

Romans 8:26 Likewise the <u>Spirit also helpeth</u> our infirmities: for we know not what we should <u>pray</u> for as we ought: but the <u>Spirit itself maketh intercession for</u> <u>us</u> with groanings which cannot be uttered.

Exodus 30:36 [Incense] shall be most holy to you.

Matthew 6:6 But thou, **when thou** <u>prayest</u>, *enter into thy closet*, and when thou hast shut thy door, <u>pray to thy Father</u> *which is in secret;* and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly.

Psalms 55:17 <u>Evening</u>, and <u>morning</u>, and at <u>noon</u>, will I <u>pray</u>, and *cry aloud*: and He shall hear my voice.

1 Thessalonians 5:17 **Pray without ceasing**.



Leviticus 24:5	And you shall take fine flour and <b>bake twelve cakes</b> with it. Two-tenths of an ephah shall be in each cake.
Leviticus 24:6	You shall set them in <b>two rows, six in a row, on the pure gold table</b> <i>before the LORD</i> .
Leviticus 24:7	And you shall put pure frankincense on each row, that it may be on the <b>bread</b> for a memorial, an offering made by fire to the LORD.
Leviticus 24:8	Every Sabbath he shall set it in order <i>before the LORD <u>continually</u>, being taken from the children of Israel by an everlasting covenant.</i>
Deuteronomy 8:3	So <u>He humbled you</u> , <u>allowed you to hunger</u> , and <b>fed you with <u>manna</u></b> which you did not know nor did your fathers know, that He might make you know that <b>man shall not live by <u>bread</u> alone</b> ; but <b>man lives by</b> <i>every</i> <u>word</u> that proceeds from the mouth of the LORD.
John 6:48	I am that bread of life.
John 6:49	Your fathers did eat manna in the wilderness, and are dead.
John 6:50	This is the <u>bread</u> which cometh down from heaven, that a man may eat thereof, and not die.
John 6:51	I am the living bread which came down from heaven
John 1:1	In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and <u>the</u> <u>Word was God</u> .

- Job 22:22 Receive, I pray thee, the <u>law from His mouth</u>, and lay up <u>His words</u> in thine heart.
- Jeremiah 15:16 Thy words were found, and I did <u>eat them</u>; and Thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart: for I am called by Thy name, O LORD God of hosts.
- Psalms 1:2 But his **delight** is in the **law of the LORD**; and in his **law** doth he **meditate** *day and night*.
- Joshua 1:8 This <u>Book of the Law</u> shall *not depart* from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it *day and night*, that you may observe to do according to <u>all</u> <u>that is written</u> in it. For <u>then you will make your way</u> prosperous, and then you will have good success.
- 2 Peter 1:21 for **prophecy** never came by the will of man, but holy men of **God spoke** as they were moved **by the Holy Spirit**.



- Exodus 25:37 You shall make **seven lamps** for it, and they shall arrange its **lamps** so that they **give light** in front of it.
- Leviticus 24:2 Command the children of Israel that they bring to you pure <u>oil</u> of **pressed olives for the light**, to make the **lamps burn <u>continually</u>**.

1 Samuel 16:13	Then Samuel took the <b>horn of <u>oil</u> and anointed</b> him in the midst of his brothers; and the <u>Spirit of the Lord</u> came upon David from that day forward
Revelation 1:20	The mystery of the seven stars which thou sawest in my right hand, and the <b>seven golden candlesticks</b> . The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches: and the <b>seven candlesticks</b> which thou sawest <b>are the</b> <b>seven churches</b> .
Revelation 2:29	He that hath an ear, let him <b>hear what the <u>Spirit</u> saith unto the churches</b> .
John 14:17	the <u>Spirit</u> of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for <b>He dwells with you and</b> <u>will be in you</u> .
John 14:18	I will not leave you orphans; <u>I <i>will come to you</i></u> .
John 14:26	But the Helper, the <b>Holy Spirit</b> , whom the Father will send in My name, <b>He will teach you all things</b> , and <b>bring to your remembrance</b> <u>all things</u> <u>that I said</u> to you.
John 15:5	"I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and <u>I in him</u> , bears much fruit; for <b>without Me you can do nothing</b> ."
Matthew 5:14	" <b>You are the light</b> of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden.
Matthew 5:15	Nor do they <b>light a lamp</b> and put it under a basket, but <b>on a lampstand</b> , and it <b>gives light to all</b> who are in the house.
Matthew 5:16	Let your light so shine before men, that they may <u>see your good works</u> and <i>glorify your Father in heaven</i> ."

John 20:21	So Jesus said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you."
John 20:22	And when He had said this, He breathed on them, and said to them, " <b>Receive the <u>Holy Spirit</u>.</b> "
Ephesians 5:18	<u>be filled</u> with the <u>Spirit</u>
Philippians 2:5	Let <b>this <u>mind</u> be <u>in you</u></b> , which was also in <u>Christ Jesus</u>
Luke 11:13	If <b>you</b> then, <b>being evil</b> , know how to <b>give good gifts to your children</b> , how much more will your <u>heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those</u> <u>who ask Him</u> !
2 Corinthians 3:18	But we all, with unveiled face, <u>beholding</u> as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the <u>Spirit</u> of the Lord.
John 1:14	And <u>the Word</u> was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we <u>beheld His</u> <u>glory</u> , the <u>glory</u> as of the only begotten <u>of the Father</u> ,) full of <i>grace and</i> <i>truth</i> .
John 17:17	<u>Sanctify them</u> through <i>Thy truth:</i> <u>Thy word</u> is <i>truth</i> .
2 Corinthians 12:9	And He said to me, " <i>My grace</i> is sufficient for you, for <i>My strength</i> is <u>made perfect</u> in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the <i>power of Christ</i> may rest upon me.
Romans 12:2	And <u>do not be conformed to this world</u> , but <b>be transformed by the renewing of your <u>mind</u></b> , that you may <i>prove</i> what is that <b>good</b> and <b>acceptable</b> and <b>perfect</b> will of God.

1 Thessalonians 4:3	For <b>this is the will of God</b> , even <b>your <u>sanctification</u>, that ye should <u>abstain from fornication</u>:</b>
1 Thessalonians 4:4	That every one of you should know how to <b>possess his vessel in</b> <u>sanctification</u> and honour
2 Thessalonians 2:13	God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth
John 8:11	"Neither do I condemn you; <b>go and <u>sin no more</u>."</b>
1 Peter 1:2	Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through <u>sanctification</u> of the <u>Spirit</u> , unto <u>obedience</u> and <i>sprinkling of the blood</i> <i>of Jesus Christ: Grace</i> unto you, and peace, be multiplied.
Galatians 2:20	I am <u>crucified</u> with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but <u>Christ liveth</u>

alatians 2:20 I am <u>crucified</u> with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but <u>Christ liveth</u> in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh <u>I live by the faith of the</u> Son of God, who loved me, and <u>gave Himself</u> for me.

1 Corinthians 15:31 ...I <u>die daily</u>.







- Exodus 25:10 And they shall **make an ark** of acacia wood...
- Exodus 25:11 And you shall **overlay it with pure gold**, **inside and out** you shall overlay it, and shall make on it a molding of **gold all around**.
- Exodus 25:21 You shall **put the** <u>mercy seat on top</u> of the ark, and **in the ark you shall** put the <u>Testimony</u> that I will give you.
- Exodus 31:18 And when He had made an end of speaking with him on Mount Sinai, He gave Moses two tablets of the <u>Testimony</u>, *tablets of stone*, *written with the finger of God*.
- Deuteronomy 4:13 So He declared to you <u>His covenant</u> which He commanded you to perform, the <u>Ten Commandments</u>; and *He wrote them on two tablets of stone*.



- Leviticus 16:15 Then he shall kill the goat of the sin offering, which is for the people, bring its blood inside the veil, do with that blood as he did with the blood of the bull, and sprinkle it on the mercy seat and before the mercy seat.
  Leviticus 16:16 So he shall make atonement for the Holy Place, because of the
- Leviticus 16:16 So he shall make <u>atonement</u> for the Holy Place, because of the uncleanness of the children of Israel, and because of their transgressions, for *all* their sins...
- Leviticus 16:30 For **on that day** the **priest shall make** <u>atonement</u> for you, to <u>cleanse you</u>, that you may be <u>clean from all your sins</u> before the LORD.

Isaiah 43:25	I, even I, am <b>He who <u>blots out your transgressions</u> for My own sake; and <u>I will not remember your sins</u>.</b>		
Isaiah 43:26	Put Me in remembrance; let us contend together; <b>state your case</b> , <u>that</u> you may be acquitted.		
Psalms 51:1	Have mercy upon me, O God, according to Your lovingkindness; according to the multitude of Your tender mercies, <u>blot out my</u> <u>transgressions</u> .		
Psalms 51:2	Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and <u>cleanse me from my sin</u> .		
Exodus 32:33	And the LORD said to Moses, <b>Whoever has sinned against Me</b> , I will <u>blot</u> him out of My book.		
Revelation 3:5	<b>He that overcometh</b> , the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will <b>not blot out his name out of the book of life</b> , but I will confess his name before My Father, and before His angels.		
Acts 17:31	because <b>He has appointed <u>a day</u> on which <u>He will judge</u> the world</b> in righteousness <b>by the Man</b> whom He has ordained. He has <b>given</b> assurance of this to all by raising Him from the dead.		
John 12:48	He who <b>rejects Me</b> , and <b>does not receive</b> <u>My words</u> , <i>has that which judges him—</i> <u>the word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day</u> .		
Matthew 22:37	Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt <u>love</u> the Lord thy God with all thy <u>heart</u> , and with all thy <u>soul</u> , and with all thy <u>mind</u> .		
Matthew 22:38	This is the first and great commandment.		
Matthew 22:39	And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself.		
Matthew 22:40	On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.		

Ecclesiastes 12:13	Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep His
	<b>commandments</b> : for this is the <b>whole duty of man</b> .

- Ecclesiastes 12:14 For **God shall bring** <u>every work into judgment</u>, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil.
- Revelation 22:14 Blessed are <u>they that do His commandments</u>, that they may have right to the tree of life, and <u>may enter in through the gates into the city</u>.
- Matthew 16:27For the Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels,<br/>and then He will reward each according to his works.

Daniel 8:16	And I heard a man's voice between the banks of Ulai, which called, and said, <b>Gabriel, make this man to <i>understand</i> <u>the vision</u>.</b>
Daniel 8:17	So he came near where I stood: and when he came, I was afraid, and fell upon my face: but he said unto me, <b>Understand</b> , O son of man: for <b>at the</b> <u>time of the end</u> shall be <u>the vision</u> .
Daniel 8:18	Now as he was speaking with me, I was in a deep sleep on my face toward the ground: but he touched me, and set me upright.
Daniel 8:19	And he said, Behold, I will make thee know <b>what shall be in the last end</b> of the indignation: for at the <u>time appointed the end</u> shall be.

Daniel 12:8	And I heard, but I understood not: then said I, O my Lord, what shall be the end of these things?
Daniel 12:9	And he said, Go thy way, Daniel: for <u>the words are closed up and sealed</u> <u>till the time of the end</u> .
Daniel 9:22	O Daniel, I am now come forth to give thee skill and <i>understanding</i> .
Daniel 9:23	therefore <i>understand</i> the matter, and <i>consider <u>the vision</u>.</i>
