It is not the greatness of the act of disobedience that constitutes <u>sin</u>, but the fact of <u>variance</u> <u>from God's expressed will in the least particular</u>; for this shows that there is yet *communion between the soul and sin*. The **heart is divided** in its service. There is a **virtual denial of God**, a **rebellion against the laws** of His government. {MB 51.3} Chapter 3 The Spirituality of the Law

Are we to follow the word of God, or the customs of the world? ...<u>God's word is plain</u>. Its teachings cannot be mistaken. Shall we obey it, just as He has given it to us, or shall we seek to find how far we can digress and yet be saved? Would that all connected with our institutions would receive and follow the divine light, and thus be enabled to transmit light to those who walk in darkness. Conformity to the world is a sin which is sapping the spirituality of our people, and seriously interfering with their usefulness. It is idle to proclaim the warning message to the world, while we deny it in the transactions of daily life. {RH March 28, 1882, par. 9-11} Where Are We Drifting?

Revelation 18:4Come out of her, My people, that ye be not partakers of her sins...

When **truth** is working only upon the <u>conscience</u>, it creates much uneasiness; but when **truth is** invited into the <u>heart</u>, the whole being is brought into captivity to Jesus Christ. <u>Even the</u> <u>thoughts are captured</u>, for the <u>mind</u> of <u>Christ works</u> where the <u>will is submitted to the will of</u> <u>God</u>. "Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus." He <u>whom the Lord makes free is</u> <u>free</u> indeed, and <u>he cannot be brought into servile bondage to sin</u>. {1MCP 324.3} Chapter 30 Conscience

But when the <u>truth</u> is received as <u>truth</u> by the <u>heart</u>, it has passed through the <u>conscience</u> and captivated the <u>soul</u> by its pure principles. It is placed in the <u>heart</u> by the <u>Holy Spirit</u>, who molds its beauty to the <u>mind</u> that its <u>transforming</u> <u>power may be seen in the character</u>. {1MCP 324.4} Chapter 30 Conscience
