Bible Study #11 Battle at the End - Part 2

1 Peter 5:8	Be sober , be vigilant ; because your adversary the devil walks about <u>like a</u> roaring lion , seeking whom he may <u>devour</u> .
Ezekiel 22:25	There is a conspiracy of her <i>prophets</i> in the midst thereof, <u>like a roaring</u> <u>lion</u> ravening the prey; they have <u>devoured</u> souls; they have taken the treasure and precious things; they have made her many widows in the midst thereof.
Ezekiel 22:26	Her priests have violated My law, and have profaned Mine holy things: they have put <u>no difference between the holy and profane</u> , <u>neither</u> have they showed <u>difference between the unclean</u> and the clean, and have hid their eyes from My Sabbaths, and I am profaned among them.
Daniel 5:1	Belshazzar the king made a great <u>feast</u> to a thousand of his lords, and drank <u>wine</u> before the thousand .
Daniel 5:3	Then they brought the golden vessels that were taken out of the temple of the house of God which was at Jerusalem; and the king, and his princes, his wives, and his concubines, drank in them .
Ezekiel 22:25	taken the treasure and precious things
Ezekiel 22:26	<u>no difference between the holy and profane</u> <i>hid their eyes from My</i> Sabbaths
Isaiah 5:12	The harp and the strings , the tambourine and flute , and <u>wine</u> are in their <u>feasts</u> ; but they <i>do not regard the work of the Lord</i> , nor consider the <i>operation of His hands</i> .

Daniel 5:4	They drank <u>wine</u> , and praised the gods of gold, and of silver, of brass, of iron, of wood, and of stone.
Daniel 5:5	In the same hour came forth fingers of a man's hand, and wrote over against the candlestick upon the plaister of the wall of the king's palace: and the king saw the part of the hand that wrote.
Daniel 5:6	Then the king's countenance was changed, and <i>his thoughts troubled him</i> , so that the joints of his loins were loosed, and his knees smote one against another.
Daniel 5:26	This is the interpretation of the thing: MENE; God hath numbered <u>thy</u> <u>kingdom</u>, and <u>finished</u> it.
Daniel 5:27	TEKEL; Thou art weighed in the balances, and art found wanting.
Revelation 18:1	And after these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power; and the earth was lightened with his glory.
Revelation 18:2	And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, <u>Babylon</u> the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.
Revelation 18:3	For <i>all</i> nations have drunk of the <u>wine</u> of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed <i>fornication with her</i> , and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies.
Revelation 18:4	And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, My people, that ye be not partakers of her sins , and that ye receive not of her plagues .

Revelation 18:5	For her sins have reached unto heaven , and God hath remembered her iniquities.
Revelation 18:6	Reward her even as she rewarded you, and double unto her double according to her works: in the cup which she hath filled fill to her double.
Revelation 18:7	How much she hath <u>glorified herself</u> , and lived deliciously, so much torment and sorrow give her: for she <u>saith in her heart</u> , I sit a queen, and am no widow , and shall see no sorrow .
Revelation 18:8	Therefore shall her plagues come in one day , death, and mourning, and famine; and she shall be utterly burned with fire : for strong is the Lord God who judgeth her.
Revelation 18:9	And the kings of the earth, who have committed fornication and lived deliciously with her, shall bewail her, and lament for her, when they shall see the smoke of her burning,
Revelation 18:10	Standing afar off for the fear of her torment, saying, Alas, alas, that great city Babylon, that mighty city! for <u>in one hour</u> is thy judgment come.
Revelation 18:11	And the merchants of the earth shall weep and mourn over her; for no man buyeth their merchandise any more:
Revelation 18:12	The merchandise of gold, and silver, and precious stones, and of pearls, and fine linen, and purple, and silk, and scarlet, and all thyine wood, and all manner vessels of ivory, and all manner vessels of most precious wood, and of brass, and iron, and marble,
Revelation 18:13	And cinnamon, and odours, and ointments, and frankincense, and wine, and oil, and fine flour, and wheat, and beasts, and sheep, and horses, and chariots, and slaves, and souls of men.
Revelation 18:14	And the fruits that thy soul lusted after are departed from thee, and all things which were dainty and goodly are departed from thee, and thou shalt find them no more at all.
Revelation 18:15	The merchants of these things, which were made rich by her, shall stand afar off for the fear of her torment, weeping and wailing,
Revelation 18:16	And saying, Alas, alas, that great city, that was clothed in fine linen, and purple, and scarlet, and decked with gold, and precious stones, and pearls!

Revelation 18:17	For <u>in one hour</u> so great riches is come to nought. And every shipmaster, and all the company in ships, and sailors, and as many as trade by sea, stood afar off,
Revelation 18:18	And cried when they saw the smoke of her burning, saying, <u>What city is</u> <u>like unto this great city</u> !
Revelation 18:19	And they cast dust on their heads , and cried, weeping and wailing , saying, Alas, alas, that great city, wherein were made rich all that had ships in the sea by reason of her costliness! for in one hour is she made desolate.
Revelation 18:21	And a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast it into the sea, saying, Thus with violence shall that great city Babylon be thrown down, and shall be found no more at all.
Revelation 18:24	And <i>in her</i> was found the blood of prophets, and of saints, and of <u>all</u> that were slain upon the earth.
Jeremiah 29:10	For thus saith the LORD, That after <u>seventy years</u> be accomplished at <u>Babylon</u> I will visit you, and perform my good word toward you, in causing you to return to this place.
Isaiah 23:17	And it shall come to pass after the end of <u>seventy years</u> , that the LORD will visit <u>Tyre</u> , and she shall turn to her hire, and shall <i>commit fornication with all the kingdoms of the world upon the face of the earth</i> .
Ezekiel 27:27	Thy riches, and thy fairs, thy merchandise, thy mariners, and thy pilots, thy calkers, and the occupiers of thy merchandise, and all thy men of war, that are in thee, and in all thy company which is in the midst of thee, shall fall into the midst of the seas in the day of thy ruin.
Ezekiel 27:28	The suburbs shall shake at the sound of the cry of thy pilots.
Ezekiel 27:29	And all that handle the oar, the mariners, and all the pilots of the sea, shall come down from their ships, they shall stand upon the land;
Ezekiel 27:30	And shall cause their voice to be heard against thee, and shall <u>cry</u> <u>bitterly</u> , <u>and shall cast up dust upon their heads</u> , they shall wallow themselves in the ashes:
Revelation 18:19	And they cast dust on their heads, and cried, weeping and wailing

Ezekiel 27:31	And they shall make themselves utterly bald for thee, and gird them with sackcloth, and they shall weep for thee with bitterness of heart and bitter wailing.
Ezekiel 27:32	And in their wailing they shall take up a lamentation for thee, and lament over thee, saying, <u>What city is like Tyre</u> , like the destroyed in the midst of the sea?
Ezekiel 27:33	When thy wares went forth out of the seas, thou filledst many people; thou didst enrich the kings of the earth with the multitude of thy riches and of thy merchandise.
Revelation 18:18	And cried when they saw the smoke of her burning, saying, <u>What city is</u> <u>like unto this great city</u> !
Revelation 18:3	the <u>kings of the earth</u> and the <u>merchants</u> of the earth are <u>waxed rich</u> through the abundance of her delicacies.
Ezekiel 27:34	In the time when thou shalt be broken by the seas in the depths of the waters thy merchandise and all thy company in the midst of thee shall fall.
Ezekiel 27:35	All the inhabitants of the isles shall be astonished at thee, and their <u>kings</u> shall be sore afraid, they shall be troubled in their countenance.
Ezekiel 27:36	The merchants among the people shall hiss at thee; thou shalt be a terror , and never shalt be any more .
Revelation 18:9	And the kings of the earth , who have committed fornication
Revelation 18:10	Standing afar off for the fear of her torment
Revelation 18:21	Thus with violence shall that great city Babylon be thrown down, and shall be found no more at all.

Ezekiel 28:1	The word of the LORD cam	e again unto me, saying,

Ezekiel 28:2 Son of man, say unto the <u>prince of Tyre</u>, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because <u>thine heart is lifted up</u>, and thou hast said, <u>I am a God</u>, <u>I sit in</u> <u>the seat of God</u>, *in the midst of the seas;* yet thou art a man, and not God, though thou set thine heart as the heart of God:

- 2 Thessalonians 2:4 who opposes and <u>exalts himself</u> above all that is called God or that is worshiped, so that he <u>sits as God in the temple of God</u>, <u>showing himself</u> <u>that he is God</u>.
- Revelation 17:15 And he saith unto me, The *waters* which thou sawest, *where the whore sitteth*, are **peoples**, and **multitudes**, and **nations**, and **tongues**.

Ezekiel 28:1	The word of the LORD came again unto me, saying,

Ezekiel 28:2 Son of man, say unto the <u>prince of Tyre</u>, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because <u>thine heart is lifted up</u>, and thou hast said, <u>I am a God</u>, <u>I sit in</u> <u>the seat of God</u>, *in the midst of the seas;* yet thou art a man, and not God, though thou set thine heart as the heart of God:

Ezekiel 28:3 Behold, <u>thou art wiser than Daniel</u>; there is <u>no secret that they can hide</u> from thee:

Ezekiel 28:4 With thy wisdom and with thine understanding thou hast gotten thee riches, and hast gotten gold and silver into thy treasures:

Ezekiel 28:5 By thy great wisdom and by thy traffick hast thou increased thy riches, and thine heart is lifted up because of thy riches:

Ezekiel 28:6	Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Because thou hast set thine heart as the heart of God ;
Ezekiel 28:7	Behold, therefore I will bring strangers upon thee, the terrible of the nations: and they shall draw their swords against the beauty of thy wisdom, and they shall defile thy brightness.
Ezekiel 28:8	They shall bring thee down to the pit, and thou shalt die the deaths of them that are slain in the midst of the seas.
Ezekiel 28:9	Wilt thou yet say before him that slayeth thee, I am God? but thou shalt be a man, and no God, in the hand of him that slayeth thee.
Ezekiel 28:10	Thou shalt die the deaths of the uncircumcised by the hand of strangers: for I have spoken it, saith the Lord GOD.
Ezekiel 28:11	Moreover the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,
Ezekiel 28:12	Son of man, take up a lamentation upon the <u>king of Tyre</u>, and say unto him, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Thou sealest up the sum, full of wisdom , and perfect in beauty .
Ezekiel 28:13	Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God; every precious stone was thy covering, the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapphire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in thee in the day that thou wast created.
Ezekiel 28:14	Thou art the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee so: thou wast upon the holy mountain of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire.
Ezekiel 28:15	Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, <i>till iniquity was found in thee</i> .

Ezekiel 28:16	By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast sinned : therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire.
Ezekiel 28:17	<u>Thine heart was lifted up</u> because of thy beauty, thou hast corrupted thy wisdom by reason of thy brightness: I will cast thee to the ground, I will lay thee before kings, that they may behold thee.
Ezekiel 28:18	Thou hast defiled thy sanctuaries by the multitude of thine iniquities, by the iniquity of thy traffick; therefore will I bring forth a <u>fire</u> from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and I will bring thee to <u>ashes</u> upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee.
Ezekiel 28:19	All they that know thee among the people shall be astonished at thee: thou shalt be a terror, and <u>never shalt thou be any more</u> .
John 14:6	Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."
Acts 4:12	Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.

1 John 1:9	If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and
	to cleanse us from all unrighteousness .

2 Corinthians 5:17	Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a <u>new creature</u>: <i>old things are passed away;</i> behold, all things are become new.
Ezekiel 36:26	I will give you a <u>new heart</u> and put a <u>new spirit</u> within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.
Ezekiel 36:27	I will put <i>My Spirit within you</i> and <u>cause you to walk</u> in My statutes, and <u>you will keep</u> My judgments and <u>do them</u> .

Galatians 3:11	But that no one is justified by the law in the sight of God is evident, for " the just shall <u>live by faith</u>."
Romans 3:31	Do we then make <i>void the law through faith?</i> Certainly not! On the contrary, <u>we establish the law</u> .
Ephesians 2:8	For by grace are ye <u>saved through faith</u>; and that not of yourselves : it is the gift of God :
Ephesians 2:9	Not of works, lest any man should boast.
Ephesians 2:10	For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto <u>good works</u>, which God hath before ordained that <u>we should walk in them</u>.
James 2:17	Thus also faith by itself , if it does not have works , is dead.
James 2:18	But someone will say, "You have faith, and I have works." Show me your faith without your works, and I will show you my faith by my works.
James 2:19	You believe that there is one God. You do well. <i>Even the demons believe</i> and tremble!
James 2:20	But do you want to know, O foolish man, that <u>faith without works is</u> <u>dead</u> ?
1 John 2:1	My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin . And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.
1 John 2:2	And <u>He Himself is the propitiation for our sins</u> , and not for ours only but also for the whole world.
1 John 2:3	Now by this we know that we know Him, if we <u>keep His</u> <u>commandments</u>.
1 John 2:4	He who says, "I know Him ," and does not <u>keep His</u> commandments , is a liar, and the truth is not in him.
1 John 2:5	But whoever <u>keeps His word</u> , truly the love of God is <i>perfected</i> in him . By this we know that we are in Him.
1 John 2:6	He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to <u>walk just as He</u> <u>walked</u> .

2 Peter 1:4	Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises : that by these ye might <u>be partakers of the divine nature</u>, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.
2 Corinthians 7:1	Therefore, having these promises , beloved, let us <i>cleanse ourselves from all filthiness</i> of the flesh and spirit, <u>perfecting holiness in the fear of God</u> .
John 15:3	<i>Now ye are <u>clean through the word</u> which I have spoken unto you.</i>
Ephesians 5:26	that He might sanctify and <u>cleanse</u> her <u>with the</u> washing of water by the <u>word</u>
Psalms 119:11	Your word I have hidden in my heart, that I might not sin against You.
Romans 8:4	that the <i>righteous requirement of the law</i> might be <i>fulfilled in us</i> who do not <u>walk</u> according to the flesh but <u>according to the Spirit</u>
Jeremiah 3:3	Therefore the <i>showers have been withheld</i> , and there has been <i>no latter rain</i> . You have had a <u>harlot's forehead</u> ; you refuse to be ashamed.
Leviticus 26:2	Ye shall <i>keep My Sabbaths</i> , and reverence my sanctuary: I am the LORD.
Leviticus 26:3	If ye walk in my statutes, and keep my commandments, and do them;
Leviticus 26:4	Then I will give you rain in due season

Beast/Antichrist says:	We can atone for our sins by various kinds of sacraments and rituals & with the merits/works of the saints and Mary
God's Word says:	Only the shed blood of Jesus Christ can atone for our sins
False Prophet says:	We can be saved by faith without a life of obedience, the law of God was nailed to the cross
God's Word says:	Saving faith finds the power for obedience in the promises of God "If you love Me, keep My commandments" John 14:15

Revelation 14:6	And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation , and kindred , and tongue , and people ,
Revelation 14:7	Saying with a loud voice, Fear God , and give glory to Him ; for the hour of His judgment is come: and <u>worship</u> Him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.
Exodus 20:8	"Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.
Exodus 20:11	For in six days the Lord <u>made the heavens and the earth</u>, the sea, and all that is in them, and <i>rested</i> the seventh day. Therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and <u>hallowed</u> it.
Revelation 14:9	If any man <u>worship</u> the beast and his image , and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand
Revelation 14:11	the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have <i>no rest</i> day nor night, who <u>worship</u> the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name.
Hebrews 4:9	There remaineth therefore <i>a rest</i> to the people of God.
Hebrews 4:10	For he that is entered into <i>His rest,</i> he also hath ceased from his own works, as God did from His.
Hebrews 4:11	Let us labour therefore to enter into <i>that rest</i>, <u>lest any man fall after the</u> same example of unbelief.
Ezekiel 20:12	Moreover I also gave them <u>My Sabbaths</u> , to be <u>a sign</u> between them and Me, that they might know that I am the Lord who sanctifies them.
Hebrews 13:8	Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.
Hebrews 13:9	Do not be carried about with various and strange doctrines . For it is good that the <i>heart be established by grace</i>
Revelation 14:12	Here is the patience of the saints : here are they that <u>keep the</u> commandments of God, and the <i>faith of Jesus</i> .

Revelation 22:18	For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of
	this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto
	him the plagues that are written in this book:

Revelation 22:19 And <u>if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this</u> <u>prophecy</u>, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.

Acts 17:30	Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, <u>but now commands all</u> <u>men everywhere to repent</u> ,
Acts 17:31	because <i>He has appointed a day</i> on which He will judge the world in righteousness by the Man whom He has ordained. He has given assurance of this to all by raising Him from the dead.
James 4:17	Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do it , to him it is sin.
Psalms 119:59	I thought about my ways, and turned my feet to Your testimonies.
Psalms 119:60	I made haste, and did not delay to <u>keep Your commandments</u> .
John 16:33	"These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation ; but be of good cheer , <u>I have overcome the world</u> ."
