#16 Death, Resurrection and the Second Coming

Genesis 2:7	And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the <u>breath</u> of life; and man <i>became a living soul</i> .
Job 33:4	The <u>Spirit</u> of God hath made me, and the <u>breath</u> of the Almighty hath <i>given me life</i> .
Job 27:3	All the while my <u>breath</u> is in me, and the <u>Spirit</u> of God is in my nostrils.
Job 27:4	My lips shall not speak wickedness, nor my tongue utter deceit .
Proverbs 20:27	The <u>spirit</u> of a man is the lamp of the LORD, <i>searching all the inner depths of his heart</i> .
John 1:4	In Him was life; and the life was the light of men.

Ecclesiastes 3:19	For that which befalleth the sons of men befalleth beasts; even one thing befalleth them: as the one dieth, so dieth the other; yea, they have all one <u>breath</u> ; so that a <i>man hath no preeminence</i> above a beast: for all is vanity.
James 2:26	For as the body without the <u>spirit</u> is dead , so faith without works is dead also.
Ecclesiastes 12:7	Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was : and the <u>spirit</u> shall return unto God who gave it.
Psalms 146:4	His <u>breath</u> goeth forth, he returneth to his earth; in that very day <i>his thoughts perish</i>

James 4:14	whereas you do not know what will happen tomorrow. For what is your life ? It is even a <i>vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away</i> .
Job 7:7	O remember that my life is <u>wind</u> : mine eye shall no more see good.
Job 7:9	As the <i>cloud</i> is consumed and vanisheth away: <i>so he that goeth down to the grave shall come up no more</i> .
Job 7:10	He shall return no more to his house, neither shall his place know him any more .

Ecclesiastes 9:5 For the living know that they shall die: but **the dead know not any thing**, neither have they any more a reward; for the **memory of them is forgotten**.

Ecclesiastes 9:6 ***Also their love***, and their **hatred**, and their **envy, is now perished**; neither have they any more a portion for ever in any thing that is done under the sun.

Ecclesiastes 9:10 Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do it with thy might; for **there is no work**, nor **device**, nor **knowledge**, nor **wisdom, in the grave**, whither thou goest.

Psalms 6:5 For **in death there is no remembrance** of Thee: **in the grave** who shall give Thee thanks?

Psalms 30:9 What profit is there in my blood, when **I go down to the pit**? **Shall the dust praise Thee?** shall it **declare Thy truth**?

Psalms 88:10 Wilt Thou **show wonders to the dead**? shall the **dead arise and praise** Thee? Selah.

Psalms 88:11 Shall Thy **lovingkindness be declared in the grave**? or Thy faithfulness in **destruction**?

Psalms 88:12 Shall Thy wonders be known **in the dark**? and Thy righteousness in the **land of forgetfulness**?

Psalms 115:17 The **dead praise not** the LORD, neither **any that go down into silence**.

Isaiah 38:18 For the **grave cannot praise** Thee, **death can not celebrate** Thee: they that go down into the **pit cannot hope** for Thy truth.

Isaiah 38:19 The living, **the living**, he **shall praise** Thee, ***as I do*** this day: the father to the children shall make known Thy truth.

Job 14:12 So **man lieth down**, and **riseth not**: *till the heavens be no more*, they shall **not awake**, nor be raised out of their **sleep**.

Psalms 13:3 Consider and hear me, O LORD my God: lighten mine eyes, lest I **sleep** the **sleep of death**

John 11:11 These things He said, and after that He said to them, "Our friend **Lazarus sleeps**, but I go that **I may wake him up**."

John 11:12 Then His disciples said, "Lord, if he sleeps he will get well."

John 11:13 However, **Jesus spoke of his death**, but they thought that He was speaking about taking rest in sleep.

John 11:14 Then ***Jesus said to them plainly***, "**Lazarus is dead**."

Acts 7:59 And they **stoned Stephen**, calling upon God, and saying, Lord Jesus, ***receive my spirit***.

Acts 7:60 And he kneeled down, and cried with a loud voice, Lord, lay not this sin to their charge. And when he had said this, **he fell asleep**.

1 Kings 2:10 So **David slept with his fathers**, and **was buried** in the city of David.

Acts 2:29 Men and brethren, let me speak freely to you of the patriarch **David**, that he **is both dead and buried**, and his **tomb is with us to this day**.

Acts 2:34 For **David did not ascend into the heavens...**

Psalms 17:15 As for me, **I will behold Thy face** in righteousness: I shall be satisfied, **when I awake**, with Thy likeness.

Isaiah 26:19 **Your dead shall live**; together with my **dead body they shall arise. Awake** and sing, you **who dwell in dust**; for your dew is like the dew of herbs, and the **earth shall cast out the dead**.

John 6:40 And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have everlasting life; and **I will raise him up at the last day**.

John 6:44 No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and **I will raise him up at the last day**.

John 11:23 Jesus said to her, "**Your brother will rise again.**"

John 11:24 Martha said to Him, "I know that he **will rise again in the resurrection at the last day**."

John 11:25 Jesus said to her, "***I am the resurrection and the life***. He who believes in Me, **though he may die, he shall live.**"

1 Corinthians 15:20 But now **Christ is risen from the dead**, and has become the firstfruits of those who have **fallen asleep**.

1 Corinthians 15:21 For since by man came death, by Man also came the **resurrection of the dead**.

1 Corinthians 15:22 For as in Adam ***all die***, even so in Christ **all shall be made alive**.

1 Corinthians 15:23 But each one in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, afterward those who are Christ's **at His coming**.

Job 19:26 And though ***after*** my skin ***worms destroy this body***, yet **in my flesh shall I see God**

- 1 Corinthians 15:51 Behold, I tell you a mystery: ***We shall not all sleep***, but we shall all be changed--
- 1 Corinthians 15:52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, **at the last trumpet**. For the trumpet will sound, and the **dead will be raised incorruptible**, and we shall be changed.
- 1 Corinthians 15:53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this **mortal must put on immortality**.
- 1 Corinthians 15:54 So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this **mortal has put on immortality**, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: **"Death is swallowed up in victory."**
- 1 Corinthians 15:55 "O Death, where is your sting? O Hades, where is your victory?"

- 1 Thessalonians 4:15 For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that **we who are alive** and remain **until the coming of the Lord** will ***by no means precede those who are asleep***.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:16 For the **Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout**, with the **voice of the archangel**, and with the **trumpet of God**. And **the dead in Christ will rise first**.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:17 Then **we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air**. ***And thus we shall always be with the Lord.***

- John 14:1 Let not your heart be troubled; you **believe in God, believe also in Me**.
- John 14:2 In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. **I go to prepare a place for you**.
- John 14:3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, **I will come again and receive you to Myself**; that ***where I am, there you may be also***.

- Revelation 22:12 And, behold, **I come quickly**; and **My reward is with me**, to give every man according as his work shall be.
- Matthew 16:27 For the **Son of Man** will **come in the glory of His Father with His angels**, and **then He will reward each** according to his works.
- 2 Timothy 4:8 Henceforth there is **laid up for me a crown** of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, **shall give me at that day**: and not to me only, but unto all **them also that love His appearing**.

- Acts 1:9 Now when He had spoken these things, while they watched, **He was taken up**, and a **cloud received Him** out of their sight.
- Acts 1:10 And while they looked steadfastly toward heaven as He went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel,
- Acts 1:11 who also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? **This same Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven**."
- 1 Thessalonians 4:17 **...in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air**. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.

- Matthew 24:27 For as the **lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west**, **so also will the coming of the Son of Man be**.
- Matthew 24:30 Then the **sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven**, and then **all the tribes of the earth** will mourn, and they **will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory**.
- Matthew 24:31 And He will send His angels with a **great sound of a trumpet**, and they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

Revelation 1:7	Behold, He cometh with clouds ; and <u>every eye shall see Him</u> , and they also which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.
Mark 14:62	Jesus said, "I am. And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven ."
Matthew 26:64	Jesus said to him, "It is as you said. Nevertheless, I say to you, hereafter <u>you will see the Son of Man</u> sitting at the right hand of the Power, and coming on the clouds of heaven ."

Psalms 50:3	Our God shall come , and shall not keep silence : a <u>fire shall devour before Him</u> , and it shall be <u>very tempestuous round about Him</u> .
Psalms 50:4	He shall <u>call to the heavens</u> from above, and <u>to the earth</u> , that he may judge His people.
Psalms 50:5	Gather my saints together unto Me ; those that have made a covenant with me by sacrifice.
Psalms 50:6	And the <u>heavens shall declare</u> his righteousness: for God is judge himself.
2 Thessalonians 1:7	and to give you who are troubled rest with us when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with His mighty angels ,
2 Thessalonians 1:8	in <u>flaming fire taking vengeance</u> on those who do not know God, and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Revelation 6:14	And the <u>heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together</u> ; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places .
Revelation 6:15	And the kings of the earth , and the great men , and the rich men , and the chief captains , and the mighty men , and every bondman , and every free man , <u>hid themselves</u> in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;
Revelation 6:16	And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and <u>hide us from the face of Him that sitteth on the throne</u> , and from the wrath of the Lamb:
Revelation 6:17	For the great day of His wrath is come ; and who shall be able to stand?
Job 14:12	So man lieth down , and riseth not : <u>till the heavens be no more</u> , they shall <u>not awake</u> , nor be raised out of their <u>sleep</u> .

Matthew 13:30 Let **both grow together until the harvest**, and at the **time of harvest** I will say to the reapers, "First gather together the **tares** and bind them in bundles to burn them, but gather the **wheat** into my barn."

Matthew 13:39 ...the harvest is the end of the world...

Matthew 25:31 When the **Son of Man comes in His glory**, and **all the holy angels with Him**, then He will sit on the throne of His glory.

Matthew 25:32 **All the nations will be gathered before Him**, and **He will separate them one from another**, as a shepherd divides **his sheep from the goats**.

Matthew 24:37 But **as the days of Noah were**, *so also will the coming of the Son of Man be*.

Matthew 24:38 For as in the days **before the flood**, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, **until the day that Noah entered the ark**,

Matthew 24:39 and **did not know until the flood came and took them all away**, *so also will the coming of the Son of Man be*.

Revelation 3:10 Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, **I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation**, which shall come upon all the world, to **try them** that dwell upon the earth.

John 17:15 I pray **not** that thou shouldest **take them out of the world**, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil.

Luke 23:43 And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, **To day shalt thou be with me in paradise**.

John 20:17 Jesus said to her, "Do not cling to Me, for **I have not yet ascended to My Father**; but go to My brethren and say to them, 'I am ascending to My Father and your Father, and to My God and your God.' "

Luke 23:43	And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee to day, shalt thou be with me in paradise.
John 20:17	Jesus said to her, "Do not cling to Me, for I have <u>not yet ascended to My Father</u> ; but go to My brethren and say to them, ' <u>I am ascending to My Father</u> and your Father, and to My God and your God.' "
Jude 1:9	Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the <u>body of Moses</u> , durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.
Genesis 4:10	And he said, What hast thou done? the voice of thy brother's blood <u>crieth unto me from the ground.</u>
Habakkuk 2:11	For the stone shall <u>cry out</u> of the wall, and the beam out of the timber shall <u>answer it.</u>
Habakkuk 2:12	Woe to him that buildeth a town with blood , and establisheth a city by iniquity!
James 5:4	Indeed the wages of the laborers who mowed your fields, which you kept back by fraud, <u>cry out</u> ; and the cries of the reapers have reached the ears of the Lord of Sabaoth.
Genesis 4:10	And he said, What hast thou done? the voice of thy brother's blood <u>crieth unto me from the ground.</u>
Hebrews 11:4	By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts ; and by it he <u>being dead yet speaketh.</u>
Revelation 6:9	...I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held :
Revelation 6:10	And they <u>cried with a loud voice</u> , saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?
Genesis 2:16	And the Lord God commanded the man, saying, "Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat;
Genesis 2:17	but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it <u>you shall surely die.</u> "
Genesis 3:4	Then the serpent said to the woman, " <u>You will not surely die.</u>
Genesis 3:5	For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened , and <u>you will be like God</u> , knowing good and evil."
Romans 1:25	who <u>exchanged the truth of God for the lie</u> , and <u>worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator</u> , who is blessed forever. Amen.

- Ezekiel 18:4 Behold, **all souls are Mine**; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die.
- 1 Timothy 6:15 which He will manifest in His own time, He who is **the blessed and only Potentate**, the King of kings and Lord of lords,
- 1 Timothy 6:16 who alone has immortality, dwelling in unapproachable light, whom **no man has seen or can see**, to whom be honor and everlasting power.
