Bible Study #4 Prophecy of the Messiah - Part 2

Daniel 9:26	And after threescore and two weeks [27 A.D.] shall <u>Messiah be cut off</u> , but not for Himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall <u>destroy the city and the sanctuary</u> ; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.
Matthew 24:1	And Jesus went out, and departed from the temple: and His disciples came to Him for to show Him the buildings of the temple.
Matthew 24:2	And Jesus said unto them, See ye not all these things? verily I say unto you, <u>There shall not be left here one stone upon another</u> , that shall not be thrown down.
Matthew 24:15	When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation , spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place , (whoso readeth, let him understand:)
Matthew 24:16	Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains
Isaiah 53:3	He is despised and rejected of men; a Man of sorrows , and acquainted with grief: and <u>we hid as it were our faces from him</u> ; He was despised, and we esteemed Him not.
Isaiah 53:4	Surely He hath borne our griefs , and carried our sorrows : yet we did esteem Him stricken, smitten of God , and afflicted .
Isaiah 53:5	But He was <u>wounded for our transgressions</u> , He was <u>bruised for our</u> <u>iniquities</u> : the chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed
Isaiah 53:6	All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on Him the iniquity of us all .
Isaiah 53:7	He was oppressed , and He was afflicted , yet He opened not His mouth : He is brought as <i>a lamb to the slaughter</i> , and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so He openeth not His mouth .
Isaiah 53:8	He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare His generation? for He was cut off out of the land of the living : <u>for the</u> <u>transgression of my people was He stricken</u> .

Isaiah 53:9	And He made His grave with the wicked , and with the rich in His death ; because He had done no violence, neither was any deceit in His mouth .
Isaiah 53:10	Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He hath put Him to grief: when thou shalt make <u>His soul an offering for sin</u> . He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand.
Isaiah 53:11	He shall see of the travail of His soul, and shall be satisfied: by His knowledge shall My righteous servant justify many ; for <u>He shall bear</u> <u>their iniquities</u> .
Daniel 9:27	And He shall confirm the covenant with many for one week : and <u>in the</u> <u>midst of the week</u> He shall cause the <u>sacrifice and the oblation to cease</u> , and for the overspreading of abominations He shall <u>make it desolate</u> , even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon <u>the desolate</u> . 31 A.D.

Mark 15:37	And <u>Jesus</u> cried out with a loud voice, and <u>breathed His last</u> .
Mark 15:38	Then the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom .
Matthew 23:37	O Jerusalem, <u>Jerusalem</u> , thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would not!

Matthew 23:38 Behold, your house is left unto you desolate.

John 8:28	Then Jesus said to them, " When you lift up the Son of Man , then you will know that I am He "
Mark 15:39	So when the centurion, who stood opposite Him, saw that He cried out like this and breathed His last, he said, " Truly this Man was the Son of God!"
Psalms 22:1	My God , My God , why have You forsaken Me ? Why are You so far from helping Me, And from the words of My groaning?
Matthew 27:46	And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is, My God , My God , why have You forsaken Me ?
Psalms 22:6	But I am a worm, and no man; A reproach of men , and despised by the people .
Psalms 22:7	All those who see Me ridicule Me ; They shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying,
Psalms 22:8	"He trusted in the Lord, let Him rescue Him; Let Him deliver Him, since He delights in Him!"
Matthew 27:42	"He saved others; Himself He cannot save. If He is the King of Israel, let Him now come down from the cross, and we will believe Him.
Matthew 27:43	He trusted in God; let Him deliver Him now if He will have Him; for He said, 'I am the Son of God.' "

Psalms 22:14	I am poured out like water , And all My bones are out of joint ; My heart is like wax ; It has melted within Me.
John 19:34	But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out .
Psalms 22:15	My strength is dried up like a potsherd, And My tongue clings to My jaws; You have brought Me to the dust of death .
John 19:28	After this, Jesus, knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the Scripture might be fulfilled, said, "I thirst!"
Psalms 22:16	For dogs have surrounded Me; The congregation of the wicked has enclosed Me. They pierced My hands and My feet
John 20:25	The other disciples therefore said to him, "We have seen the Lord." So he said to them, "Unless I see in His hands the print of the nails , and put my finger into the print of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe."
Psalms 22:17	I can count all My bones. They look and stare at Me.
John 19:32	Then the soldiers came and broke the legs of the first and of the other who was crucified with Him.
John 19:33	But when they came to Jesus and saw that He was already dead, they did not break His legs
Psalms 22:18	They divide My garments among them, And for My clothing they cast
	lots.
Matthew 27:35	Then they crucified Him, and divided His garments , casting lots , that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet: "They divided My garments among them, and for My clothing they cast lots."

Psalms 16:10	For You will not leave my soul in Sheol, nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption .
Hosea 6:2	After two days will He revive us: in the third day He will raise us up, and we shall live in His sight.
Psalms 68:18	Thou hast ascended on high , Thou hast <u>led captivity captive</u> : Thou hast received gifts for men ; yea, <i>for the rebellious also</i> , <u>that the LORD God</u> <u>might dwell among them</u> .
Revelation 1:18	I am He that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the <u>keys of hell and of death</u> .
Luke 24:36	Now as they said these things, Jesus Himself stood in the midst of them, and said to them, "Peace to you."
Luke 24:37	But they were terrified and frightened, and supposed they had seen a spirit.
Luke 24:38	And He said to them, "Why are you troubled? And why do doubts arise in your hearts?
Luke 24:39	Behold My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself . Handle Me and see , for a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see I have."
Luke 24:40	When He had said this, He showed them His hands and His feet.
Luke 24:41	But while they still did not believe for joy, and marveled, He said to them, "Have you any food here?"
Luke 24:42	So they gave Him a piece of a broiled fish and some honeycomb.
Luke 24:43	And He took it and ate in their presence.
Luke 24:44	Then He said to them, "These are the words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms concerning Me ."
Luke 24:45	And He opened their <i>understanding,</i> that they might <i>comprehend</i> the Scriptures.

Acts 7:54	When they heard these things they were cut to the heart, and they gnashed at him with their teeth.
Acts 7:55	But he, being full of the Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus <u>standing</u> at the right hand of God,
Acts 7:56	and said, "Look! I see the heavens opened and the Son of Man <u>standing</u> at the right hand of God!"
Acts 7:57	Then they cried out with a loud voice, stopped their ears, and ran at him with one accord;
Acts 7:58	and they cast him out of the city and stoned him. And the witnesses laid down their clothes at the feet of a young man named Saul.
Acts 7:59	And they stoned Stephen as he was calling on God and saying, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit."



Hebrews 1:3	who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, <u>sat down</u> at the right hand of the Majesty on high
Daniel 7:9	I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days <u>did sit</u> , whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of His head like the pure wool: His throne was like the fiery flame, and His wheels as burning fire.
Daniel 7:10	A fiery stream issued and came forth from before Him: thousand thousands ministered unto Him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before Him: the judgment was set , and the <u>books were opened</u> .
Ezekiel 9:3	Now the glory of the God of Israel had gone up from the <u>cherub</u> , where it had been, <u>to the threshold</u> of the temple. And He called to the man clothed with linen, who had the writer's inkhorn at his side;
Psalms 99:1	The LORD <u>reigneth</u> ; let the people tremble: He <u>sitteth</u> between the cherubims; let the earth be moved.
Ezekiel 9:3	Now the glory of the God of Israel had gone up from the <u>cherub</u> , where it had been, <u>to the threshold</u> of the temple. And He called to the man clothed with linen, who had the writer's inkhorn at his side;
Ezekiel 9:4	and the Lord said to him, "Go through the midst of the city, through the midst of Jerusalem, and put a mark on the foreheads of the men who sigh and cry over all the abominations that are done within it."
Ezekiel 9:5	To the others He said in my hearing, " Go after him through the city and kill ; do not let your eye spare, nor have any pity.
Ezekiel 9:6	Utterly slay old and young men, maidens and little children and women; but do not come near anyone on whom is the mark ; and begin at My sanctuary." So they began with the elders who were before the temple.

James 5:9	Do not grumble against one another, brethren, <i>lest you be condemned</i> . Behold, the Judge is <u>standing at the door</u>!
Luke 13:24	"Strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many , I say to you, will seek to enter and will not be able.
Luke 13:25	When once the Master of the house has <u>risen up</u> and <u>shut the door</u>, and you begin to stand outside and knock at the door, saying, 'Lord, Lord, open for us,' and He will answer and say to you, 'I do not know you, where you are from,'
Luke 13:26	then you will begin to say, 'We ate and drank in Your presence, and You taught in our streets.'
Luke 13:27	But He will say, 'I tell you I do not know you, where you are from. Depart from Me, all you workers of iniquity.' "
Daniel 12:1	And at that time shall Michael <u>stand up</u> , the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble , such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at that time thy <u>people</u> shall be <u>delivered</u> , every one that shall be found <u>written in the book</u> .
Matthew 21:43	Therefore say I unto you, The kingdom of God <u>shall be taken from you</u> , and given to a nation bringing forth the fruits thereof.
Matthew 26:17	Now the first day of the Feast of the Unleavened Bread the disciples came to Jesus, saying to Him, "Where do You want us to prepare for You to eat the <u>Passover</u> ?"
Matthew 26:18	And He said, "Go into the city to a certain man, and say to him, The Teacher says, "My time is at hand; I will keep the <u>Passover</u> at your house with My disciples."
Matthew 26:19	So the disciples did as Jesus had directed them; and they prepared the Passover .
Matthew 26:20	When evening had come, He sat down with the twelve.

John 19:31	Therefore, because it was the Preparation Day , that the <u>bodies should</u> <u>not remain on the cross on the Sabbath</u> (for that Sabbath was a high day), the Jews asked Pilate that their legs might be broken, and that they might be taken away.
1 Corinthians 5:7	Therefore purge out the old leaven , that you may be a new lump , since you truly are unleavened . For indeed <u>Christ</u> , <u>our Passover</u> , was sacrificed for us.
1 Corinthians 5:8	Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the <u>unleavened bread</u> of sincerity and truth.
Matthew 28:1	Now <u>after the Sabbath</u> , as the <u>first day of the week</u> began to dawn, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to see the tomb.
Matthew 28:2	And behold, there was a great earthquake; for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven , and came and rolled back the stone from the door , and sat on it.
Matthew 28:3	His countenance was like lightning, and his clothing as white as snow.
Matthew 28:4	And the guards shook for fear of him, and became like dead men.
Matthew 28:5	But the angel answered and said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek <u>Jesus</u> who was crucified .
Matthew 28:6	He is not here ; for <u>He is risen</u> , as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay.
1 Corinthians 15:20	But now <u>Christ is risen</u> from the dead, and has <u>become the firstfruits</u> of those who have fallen asleep.
1 Corinthians 15:21	For since by man came death, by Man also came the resurrection of the dead.
1 Corinthians 15:22	For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive.
1 Corinthians 15:23	But each one in his own order: <u>Christ the firstfruits</u> , afterward those who are Christ's at His coming.

Acts 1:4	And being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem , but to wait for the Promise of the Father , "which," He said, "you have heard from Me;
Acts 1:5	for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."
Acts 2:1	When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.
Acts 2:41	Then those who gladly received his word were baptized ; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them.
Acts 2:47	praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.

Died on Calvary → 14th Nisan Passover

Rested in the tomb ----- 15th Nisan Unleavened Bread

Resurrected — 16th Nisan **First Fruits**

Poured out Holy Spirit → 6th Sivan **Pentecost**
