#### Bible Study #5 The Little Horn

2 Thessalonians 2:1	Now, brethren, <b>concerning the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ</b> and our gathering together to Him, we ask you,
2 Thessalonians 2:2	not to be soon shaken in mind or troubled, either by spirit or by word or by letter, as if from us, as though the day of Christ had come.
2 Thessalonians 2:3	<i>Let no one deceive you</i> by any means; for <b>that Day will not come unless</b> <b>the <u>falling away comes first</u></b> , <b>and the <u>man of sin is revealed</u></b> , the <i>son of</i> <i>perdition</i> ,
2 Thessalonians 2:4	who <b>opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or that is</b> worshiped, so that he sits as God in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God.

1798 A.D.Napoleon's General Berthier deposed Pope Pius VI taking him into<br/>custody, effectively removing the power of the sword from the control<br/>of the Roman Catholic Church
