Bible Study The Seven Churches Part 1 - Ephesus

Revelation 1:1	The Revelation of Jesus Christ , which God gave unto Him, to show unto His servants <u>things which must shortly come to pass</u> ; and He sent and signified it by His angel unto His servant John:
Revelation 1:7	Behold, <u>He cometh with clouds</u> ; and every eye shall see Him, and they also which pierced Him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of Him. Even so, Amen.
Revelation 1:3	Blessed is he that <u>readeth</u> , and they that <u>hear</u> the words of this <u>prophecy</u> , and <u>keep</u> those things which are written therein: for the <i>time is at hand</i> .
Revelation 1:10	I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day , and heard behind me a great voice , as of a trumpet,
Revelation 1:11	Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the First and the Last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send it unto <u>the seven churches</u> which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.

Acts 19:10	And this continued by the space of two years; so that all they which dwelt in Asia heard the word of the Lord Jesus , both Jews and Greeks.

Ephesus was the largest city in Asia Minor during Paul's ministry - pop. 1/4 million Church membership reached 50k people during the height of the gospel explosion Preachers included Paul, Apollos, Timothy, and John Mary the mother of Jesus is said to have lived there It was located where the Cayster River meets in the Aegean Sea in modern Turkey

Acts 19:34	But when they knew that he [Paul] was a Jew, all with one voice about the space of two hours cried out , Great is Diana of the Ephesians .

Diana was the many breasted pagan moon goddess of fertility - <u>mother of the gods</u> Popularity of Christianity threatened the trade of silver images that flourished there Council of Ephesus 431 A.D. gave the title <u>Mother of God</u> to Christ's mother Mary The image of Mary replaced that of Diana and the tradition of statues continued Temple of Artemis - 4x size of the Parthenon 117 columns 66' high 7' thick The amphitheater in Ephesus was able to seat 25k is the location of Acts 19:34

Nicolaitans were influenced by Gnosticism which had infiltrated thru new members Nicolaitans taught <u>antinomianism</u> - Christians were not subject to the law anymore The liberty of the gospel that Paul preached was turned into a license to sin **Nicolaitans did not believe in the need to overcome sin in their lives**
